

Youth media centre

The aim of the youth media centre will be a complete report of the whole development around the youth parliament 2010 in Montevideo. A group of about 10 pupils, advised by an expert, will be instructed with the management of the central press centre, whose principal function will be the coverage and the documentation of every information related to the event: opening, commission work and closing of the parliament; furthermore all the activities of the young parliamentarians during their stay in Uruguay.

The instructed pupils of the press centre will have the opportunity to get in contact and to exchange experiences with other people from 3 continents as well as to participate in all activities.

The press groups will be formed according to the different activities. In an optimal way, there will be two responsible editors or supervisors, so that a process in a correct way can be assured. However, this is in no way a permission to hold back or to censor any information received by other parliamentarians. The main task of the supervisors will be the assuring that the daily material will be obtained in time and to write the blog. This role might be rotative.

Blog

The task will be the daily actualisation of the blog with the most important information of the whole day. On the blog, impressions, daily experiences, pictures and helpful links can be posted, and above all, there will be the possibility to get in contact with colleagues following the parliament from different countries, and doubts or consults might be commented.

The online newspaper

There will be the possibility to compose news and reports of a single day and to broadcast them via the electronic newspaper, which will be accessible on the blog.

Every single broadcasted report should be edited and rectified by the same pupils, with help and consults of an instructed expert or a teacher. The report might contain pictures, graphics and the entire information which the pupil considers to be worthy of mention for the news chain. For that, the instructed group will get in contact with the material and technical aspects of journalistic work.
