

Goethe-Institut Glasgow Library Terms and Conditions

Our library is open to everyone.

Anyone can visit the library and use the materials free of charge. In order to **borrow** materials, you require a **valid membership**. To obtain membership you will need to either visit the Goethe-Institut library or fill out the **registration form** online.

Please provide **current proof of address** (i.e. driving licence, utility bill, etc) and, if applicable, **proof for concessionary* rate**. We will send out an invoice to you with the appropriate membership fee and ask for payment within 14 days by bank transfer.

The details you submit will be stored in a database held by the Goethe-Institut in Germany, and will be used exclusively for the legitimation, implementation and completion of the library loans agreement. The stored data will not be passed on to third parties. Library users have the right to view the data kept about them at any time. All library users are responsible for informing the library of changes to their

BORROWING ITEMS

You can borrow up to a **maximum** of **10 items (10 books, 3 CDs / DVDs / Magazines or 2 board games)** at any given time. The latest editions of newspapers/magazines are not available for borrowing.

Loan periods:

4 weeks for books, CDs and magazines (3 extensions possible)
2 weeks for DVDs and games (3 extensions possible on request)
Overdue items incur a fine of 25p per day, per item.
Extensions can be made in the Online catalogue goethe.de/glasgow/library or by contacting the library.

Notifications, receipts, and reminders regarding library loans are sent by email. This agreement with the Goethe-Institut Library can be cancelled at any time by informing the library staff in writing.

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It is also possible to **reserve items**, which are out on loan.

For library members living outside the Central Belt area we might be able to send items via the **postal service**. Return postage costs will have to be paid by library members.

Library members are responsible for taking care of the items they borrow. If items are **lost or damaged** while being borrowed, the library member is responsible for providing suitable compensation to the library. Depending on the type of loss or damage to materials sustained the library will determine the amount and type of compensation due. A flat fee of £15 will be charged for items which are lost and cannot be replaced because they are out of print / no longer available.
