<b>Time</b>	<b>Task</b>						
00:00	PPT showing first slide, introductions (where necessary)						
00:02	Split the class into two teams to write on the board words they associate with 'German' in a mind map relay. Which team wins?						
00:06	Quick discussion of some of the words on the board (any stereotypes? Any unexpected insight?)						
00:08	<i>Lernziel</i> slide - talk through the expectations of the session						
00:10	Students to complete Quizizz on knowledge about Germany						
00:20	Update the mind map on the board (using a second colour)						
00:23	Song ( <i>Andreas Bourani - Auf Uns</i> ) <i>- Show video, with students identifying relevant words. There are three levels of gap-fill task, dependant on student confidence</i> <i>- Listen to the song two-three more times to complete the lyrics</i>						
00:50	Show the English lyrics slide. Which box (A-F) fits each part of the song?						
01:00	Based on the song/background, can we add anything to the mind map? (using a third colour)						
01:02	Set up cultural research groups which they will present to the others later. Students get a general overview and questions they need to answer through their research.
