## *Fly Me to The Moon*

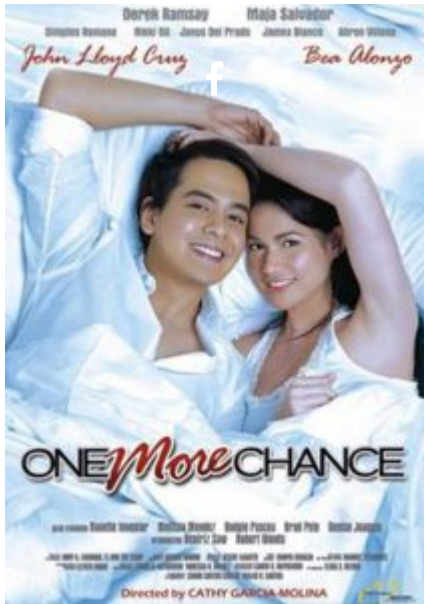
