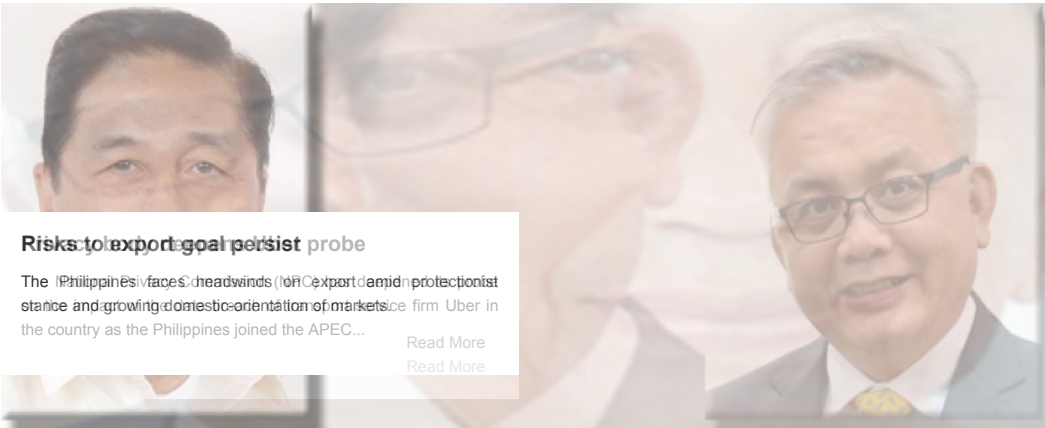

Science Film Festival 2017 unreels at IMAX

The annual Science Film Festival recently unreels with a special screening of the documentary "Voyage of Time" at the IMAX Theater in SM North EDSA.

A joint project of the Goethe-Institut Philippinen in partnership with IMAX Asia Pacific, and SM, this annual event encourages films that deal with science-related issues and ideas about evolution and creation that made the planet. Now on its eighth year in the Philippines, the Science Film Festival is Goethe-Institut's contribution to science and education in the country.

With this year's theme, "Anthropocene: The Age of Humanity," the festival aimed to discuss the commencement of human impact on the Earth's geology and ecosystems, including climate change.

The festival's opening film, "Voyage of Time is a spectacular documentary narrated by Brad Pitt which immerses audience directly into the story of the universe and life itself. The breathtaking footage of the film shows the grand history of the cosmos, the birth of the stars and galaxies to the explosion of diverse life-forms on Earth.
