Public lectures on history

The Lopez Museum and Library (LML) presents the third and fourth installment of LML's lecture series entitled "Off the Pages," done in partnership with the Ateneo de Manila Department of History. On Oct. 21, LML will host back-to-back lectures, given by Prof. Francis Navarro, PhD., and Prof. Jo-ed Tirol, PhD. They will be giving the lectures "Translation, Transmission, and Paleography: Looking into Spanish Documents (16th-19th century)," and "Of Forgetting and Remembering: Social Memory, Commemoration, and the Jewish Refugees in the Philippines during the Second World War" respectively. The first talk is at 10 a.m. to noon, and the second is from 1 p.m.-3 p.m. The two lectures tackle Philippine history from different vantage points, one overlooked, the other rarely explored. Registrants can avail of a discounted rate should they want to attend both lectures.
