## LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY

### FOUR-week intensive German course at a Goethe-Institute in Germany

#### TARGET GROUPS

- Teachers of German in primary and secondary schools in Australia who feel the need to improve their German language skills.
- University Students currently enrolled in a Diploma of Education course in Australia and aspiring to be teachers of German.
- Librarians managing the Goethe-Institut's Resource Centres.
- Principals and persons in key positions in education with a good basic knowledge of German.

#### LOCATIONS

Berlin, Bonn, Dresden, Düsseldorf, Freiburg, Göttingen, Hamburg, Mannheim, München or Schwäbisch Hall (Preferred course location of applicant will be taken into consideration but cannot be guaranteed; further information on course locations is available on [goethe.de/germany](http://goethe.de/germany), Intensive 4 courses).

#### DATES

**From January 2019 to December 2019**– commencing monthly.

Please check term dates in your state as the course dates & school holidays should coincide.

However, if your school/university is prepared to release you at other times, you may apply for courses at other times as well. Course dates are available below and on [goethe.de/germany](http://goethe.de/germany) (Intensive 4 courses).

#### THE LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY SCHOLARSHIP INCLUDES

- tuition for a Goethe-Institut "Intensive 4" German language course: approx. 80 teaching units (1 unit = 45 minutes) in the German language plus a social and cultural program
- accommodation (single room in a student hostel or with a private host) with breakfast for the duration of the course. Please note that the amount for accommodation is not redeemable in cash if you decide to make your own arrangement.
- one main meal on course days (not Saturdays, Sundays or public holidays)
- basic health insurance for the duration of the course (arrival day to departure day)
- a travel allowance of Euro 800 on arrival in Germany.

#### CONDITIONS (see also: further terms & conditions of scholarship)

The applicant must

- be an Australian citizen or have been a permanent resident of Australia for at least two years and be committed to remain in Australia six years. (The language courses are not intended for native speakers)
- belong to the target group
- be committed to **teaching German in Australia for another six years**
- not have received a scholarship to the Federal Republic of Germany in the last two years (2016-2018)
- on completion of the course write a short report about the scholarship (one to two A-4 pages) detailing if the experience a) improved the cultural knowledge, b) the language proficiency, and c) whether you would recommend the program to others.
- be willing to spend one month overseas

#### APPLICATION PROCEDURE

1. **Teachers: Check first with your school authority** (eg. DET, AIS, Catholic Education, etc.) if any additional forms are required, if the application should be sent to this authority first and **by which date**, or if a copy of the email is sufficient.
2. **Complete online the electronic pdf form** "[Bewerbungsformular/Application Form](#)" and follow the instructions on the screen, complete the form and **email** to us.
3. **Sign the Teilnahmebedingungen** and send to us in the original, or scanned with your signature by email
4. **Complete the word form** "[Zusatzformular/ Supplementary Form](#)" and email to us.
5. Send/email or fax us a **letter of support**/reference from your principal/university.
