## Goethe-Institut presents series *KinoKonzert: Film + Live Music*

The Goethe-Institut and its Australian partners are proud to present *KinoKonzert: a* bi-monthly series of amazing audio-cinematic experiences at selected Australian cinemas. Co-curated by independent curator and producer Christian Pazzaglia, the program features exclusive performances of new original live soundtracks by German and Australian artists for a number of landmark German silent films.

Hot on the heels of its first edition, which saw Alexander Hacke & Danielle de Picciotto performing at *Dark Mofo* in Hobart, *Revelation Film Festival* in Perth, *ACMI* in Melbourne and *Event Cinemas George Street* in Sydney, the next instalment is coming up in September:

## Chiara Kickdrum / Vampyr

The second *KinoKonzert* brings together a legendary silent film with a contemporary electronic soundtrack: we asked Melbourne-based DJ and composer Chiara Kickdrum to compose and perform a new original score for the German–French horror film *Vampyr*, directed in 1932 by visionary director, Carl Theodor Dreyer.

While Chiara Kickdrum is best known for pumping techno sets at clubs and festivals, she is also a classically trained musician who just returned from Cannes Film Festival where *All These Creatures*, the latest film she scored, was awarded a Palme D'Or.

When asked about the haunting nature of Carl Theodor Dreyer's Vampyr, Chiara says: "I have always been intrigued by horror films. Back in Italy, I grew up watching Dario Argento's movies such as *Suspiria* and *Phenomena* and I remember loving them, even when I was very young."

Don't miss this unique opportunity to watch *Vampyr* as you've never seen – or rather *heard* – it before.
