# GENERAL INFORMATION

Home visit Europe is a performance that travels from one place in Europe to another trying to answer to questions such as: What is Europe actually? How much Europe is in us all? With 'Home Visit Europe' Rimini Protokoll brings the abstract idea of Europe to an individual level since the performances take place in a private apartment. In this private apartment 15 people, friends and strangers, become part of a performance that interweaves personal stories and political mechanism of Europe. Usually 'Home Visit Europe' takes place in one town for a limited period most often within the framework of a festival.

The performance itself consists of five different levels with different questions that are answered by the participants. Once level four is reached, teams will be formed and the following game will determine the division of a cake that is baked during the performance.



So how does one become part of 'Home Visit Europe'? You can either be the host of the performance or you can be a guest in stranger's private apartment. Each performance will take place in a different private apartment building a network throughout Europe that stretches from one front door to another.

# RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE HOST

---

1. The host can invite two friends or family members but there will be also twelve tickets available for the public. The address of the host will not be published! The address will only be available once a ticket is booked.
2. The number of guests cannot be more than 15 people.
3. If the host is not able to host the performance for some reason, he or she should inform the organizer (Home for Cooperation) at least two weeks in advance.
4. The host does not need to provide anything apart from a table, chairs and an oven. If anything extra (for example chairs) is needed please let the organizer know.
5. The organizer will provide the cake mix and anything else that is needed for the performance.
6. During the performance there should not be anything on the table (no snacks etc.) and nothing should be offered to the guests.
