

Film fans have a lot to expect from the third German Film Week, which will run from Nov. 6– 11. Organized by the Goethe Institut, this year's films are said to be the "latest and hottest" movies from Germany that were released in the past two years.

Tickets are priced at only PHP100 (US\$1.87), more than half the price of regular tickets. A total of 10 German movies, many of which are critics' favorites, will screen at SM Aura Premier in Taguig and SM City North EDSA in Quezon City.

Those living in Baguio, Cebu, and Cagayan de Oro, can also watch some of the movies when they're screened at those cities later in the year.

From comedies to dramas, here are what film fans can expect from the festival.

### Only God Can Judge Me by Özgür Yildirim
