The 12th International Silent Film Festival Starts on Thursday!

Mark your calendars as eight silent films will start screening on Thursday, August 30. On its 12th year, the International Silent Film Festival (ISSF) is a collaboration of cultural institutions led by Goethe Institut Philippinen and will feature silent films from Italy, Philippines, France, Germany, Japan, USA, Spain, and Austria, all of which were released in the 1920s.

In addition, eight local musicians will live-score these films as it plays. These local musicians include the Miles Experience, Kontra-GaPi, Tanikala Tribe, and Brass Munkeys to name a few.

From August 30 to September 2, SM Megamall will house these silent films for free. The screening is for the general public on a first-come, first-served basis.


