



Conditions of participation in the International German Olympics 2020

Participants of the International German Olympics 2020 (7/26/2020 – 8/8/2020) must be at least 14 years old but not older than 17 years at the time of the contest. In other words, participants must be born no later than August 7, 2002 but not earlier than July 26, 2006 in order to participate.

Students who grew up bilingual with at least one German-speaking parent or guardian cannot participate.

Students who have lived in German speaking countries for more than six months after the age of three cannot participate.

Students enrolled at a school where the teaching and communication language is mainly German cannot participate. Such schools are for example German immersion schools, German Schools Abroad and local private schools with a focus on German.

Students who have already received a scholarship for a language course in Germany in 2020 cannot participate.

Students who have begun to study at a university or college are ineligible.

Providing false information and lying about your background will be grounds for disqualification.
