

## **Artist's residency in Gwangju, Republic of Korea**

Duration: September to November 2020 (three months)

As part of an exchange program, the Cultural Office of the State Capital of Munich, the Gwangju Museum of Art and the Goethe Institute offer a Munich-based artist a three-month stay as artist-in-residence in Gwangju, Republic of Korea. The stay takes place during the Gwangju Biennale.

- living expenses in Gwangju for three months (€ 1,200 per month)
- work space
- public presentation in the format of an "open studio" and a solo exhibition
