

Currently on tour across the globe, the "Pure Gold" exhibition comes to Manila tomorrow and will be hosted for a month by the UP Vargas Museum. Co-presented by Goethe-Instut, the German cultural embassy in the Philippines, the design exhibition assembles 76 pieces from 53 designers from seven regions around the world, showcasing upcycled unconventional furniture designs that creatively process unwanted by-products. The exhibit's curator, Volker Albus, will conduct a walk-through of the exhibit and talk about upcycling in Europe on Thursday. Interested participants can RSVP at +639158175314.

Admission is free for tomorrow's opening night, after which a museum fee of PHP30 (US\$.30) will be charged in subsequent days.

VISIT A ONE-DAY-ONLY OPEN HOUSE TO MANILA'S HISTORICAL WALLED CITY



Intramuros, Manila's historical walled city is waiving fees and door charges on some of its tourist sites, including Fort Santiago, Museo San Agustin, Destileria Limtuaco Museum, and the Bagumbayan Light and Sound Museum, which will cost you a total of PHP525 (US\$10) in entrance fees. Free rides on Intramuros' *tranvias* (19th century trams), as well as bamboo bike rentals, and GrabWheels scooters, are also thrown in for good measure. One day only.


