The 2020 People's Climate March will take place in Tel Aviv on Friday, March 27th, in cooperation with environmental and social organizations, schools, dozens of communities from all over the country, and the Tel Aviv Municipality.

A little background: In the past few years, the People's Climate March has become the major annual event of the environmental movement in Israel. From year to year we witness a significant increase in the number of participants, partnerships and cooperation with a wide range of civil society organizations, activists and communities. Around the world and in Israel there is rising public awareness and engagement, as thousands of people, youth and adults, understand that the climate crisis is one of the most critical and urgent challenges we are facing and realize the need for immediate action.

What began as a few hundred participants in the first march in Israel in 2015 turned into a large public mobilization by 2019, with 7,000 participants marching together for climate justice!
