Thank you for your interest in our language courses!

With our upcoming A1-Course we are going Blended! Blended-Learning is the need of the hour and it is for your comfort and convenience, coupled with our internationally designed Blended-Learning course. You don't want to miss this bus! So how does Blended-learning work anyway?

Course Structure:

As the name suggests, it is a combination of tools. The course is structured in such a way, that you will attend classes on alternate days, and on the other alternate days you will complete lessons on our online course book. The number of hours you learn everyday will depend on the course you have registered for – intensive weekday/super-intensive/intensive weekend.

In short: 50 % Online + 50 % Offline = Blended-Learning

The online course book:

In our standard interactive online course book, you can repeat exercises any number of times. These exercises contain reading, listening, writing and speaking exercises. Goethe Institute has been offering online courses worldwide with this online book for many years now.

The Offline classes:

Classroom teaching will take place on alternate days, and will include revision, more practice and exercises, especially speaking- exercises. It will also include guidance for the online lessons, as also examination training.

***Please note:** During the Lock down, the offline classes will be conducted in digital classrooms, and will be replaced by classes at MMB, Pune after the Lock down.

Duration of the course:

The Blended-Learning Course has exactly the same number of hours as our regular courses, i.e. 160 teaching units (each unit is 45 Minutes). So the last date of the course will coincide with the last date of all courses mentioned on our website.

Examinations:

This course includes training for the exam Start Deutsch 1 – the Goethe Institut exam that one appears for after the A1 course. At the end of this course, you can appear for this exam as an internal candidate.

Discount on Course fees:

The fees are the same as of our regular courses. (INR 24,000)

However during this Corona pandemic, we would like to appreciate your efforts to learn a new language and hence we are offering a discount of 10% on the tuition fees for the upcoming course starting on 25.05.2020. The tuition fees hence will be Rs. 21600/-

Other advantages:

This course structure is extremely advantageous for the beginner levels, and is a tried and tested model the world over. You can repeat and revisit classes, as well as follow your own learning progress on the online platform. This is independent learning, coupled with guidance and further practice from our teachers on the offline days. So you really have the best of both worlds here!
