



Precautionary and hygiene measures for public access and for conducting examinations and language courses at the Goethe-Institut Cyprus

The exams in June/July and the summer courses in June/August 2020 will be held under strict precautionary and hygiene measures.

The hygiene concept takes into account the current requirements of the Cypriot Ministry of Education. They also apply to public access to the Language Course Office and the Event Hall.

1. Public access / Events

- Persons should only enter the main building for important reasons (collection of certificates personal enrolment, registration for events).
- When entering the building, visitors should disinfect their hands and wait until they are called by an employee.
- Wearing a mask is recommended.
- For visits to the reopened exhibitions from 01.-09.06 in the period from 10:00 to 18:00, up to 9 people can be in the hall at the same time. We kindly ask for a short advance registration by phone or email.
- Entrance and emergency doors of the hall remain open during the whole period for better ventilation.

2. Examinations

- The number of candidates per examination is limited to ten. However, there are more examination dates available than in previous years.
- All exams take place exclusively in the hall with distance regulations.
- Examination candidates must disinfect their hands when entering and leaving the hall. Necessary disinfectants are provided.
- The wearing of masks is recommended for mutual protection. Subjects should bring their own masks and gloves if necessary.
- A minimum distance of 1.5 metres should be maintained during the test and breaks. There are distance markings on the floor.
- The examination rooms are carefully cleaned and disinfected before the examinations. Entrance and emergency doors remain open during the whole period for better ventilation.

- Participants will not be allowed access to the main building. Our staff will receive participants under the pergola in the front garden.
- Accompanying persons are requested to leave the premises as soon as possible and not to stay in the corridors of the Institute under any circumstances.

3. **Language Courses**

- Students must disinfect their hands when entering and leaving the classroom. Necessary disinfectants are provided.
- The number of students per class is limited to 12. Each student has their own table.
- The minimum distance between tables is 1 metre. The minimum distance between teacher and students is 2 metres.
- The common use of pens, etc. is not permitted.
- There must be no “group gatherings” during the breaks.
- Group work with close contact may not take place.
- The wearing of masks is suggested for mutual protection.
- Accompanying persons are requested to leave the premises as soon as possible and not to remain in the halls of the institute under any circumstances.

We request all visitors to comply with the distance and hygiene rules.

All rules will be adjusted to any new rules issued by the authorities.
