SOCCER STATEMENTS

1. There are eleven players and one goalkeeper in each soccer team.
Answer: *False, there are ten players and one goalkeeper, i.e. eleven in total in each team.*
2. You must not use your hands to play the ball (unless you are the goalkeeper!)
Answer: *True*
3. You must not use your head to play the ball (unless you are the goalkeeper!)
Answer: *False, you are allowed to head the ball to advance or score a goal.*
4. A soccer match usually lasts 90 minutes with a 15-minute break after 45 minutes.
Answer: *true*
5. Soccer is always played on real grass.
Answer: *false, the pitch can also be made of manmade materials such as AstroTurf. But the color of any artificial surface must always be green.*
6. The Soccer World Cup is the most watched sporting event worldwide.
Answer: *True, the Soccer World Cup was watched by 3.4 billion people worldwide in 2018 compared to the Super Bowl, which is watched by approximately 100 million.*
7. Brazil won the World Cup in 2018 and is currently World Champion.
Answer: *False, the World Cup in 2018 was won by France.*
8. Germany has won the World Cup four times.
Answer: *False, Germany has won the World Cup four times: in 1954, 1974, 1990, and in 2014.*
9. The German club FC Bayern Munich is the biggest sports club in the world.
Answer: *True, since 2014 this club with 125,000 members has been the biggest sports club in the world.*
10. The German national team usually wears blue tricots.
Answer: *False, the German national team usually plays in white tricots. Blue tricots are often used by the French and by the Italian national teams.*
