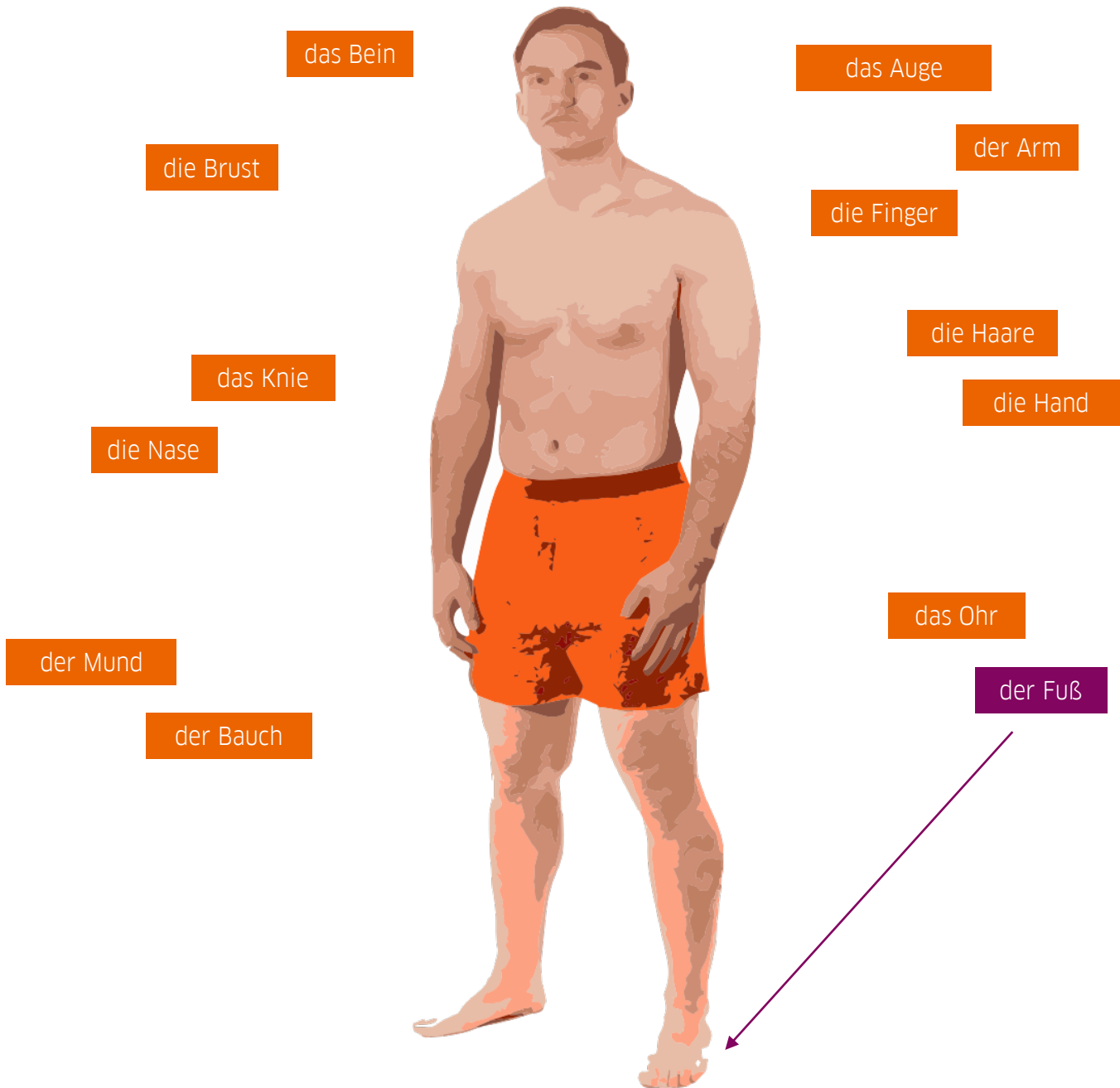

MY ECOLOGICAL FOOTPRINT

Definition

The Ecological Footprint definition is a way to measure how much of nature's resources we use and consume and how much waste we produce. It calculates our impact on our environment.

You can define four different areas of impact:

1. *Food*
2. *Energy*
3. *Transportation*
4. *Goods and Services*



Task

Work with a group and select one of these four areas. Think of examples of how humans have impact on the environment within the area you selected. Take notes, so you can present your examples to the rest of the class.

Example

Exotic fruit we eat, such as bananas or avocados, need land and water to be produced. Sometimes, chemicals are involved in the production. These chemicals can accumulate in the soil. The fruits are often transported over long distances to reach our supermarkets. This creates fuel exhausts. And what about the packaging?
