## WHY? ACCESS + PRESERVATION + DIGITAL HERITAGE



- Difficult to make educational resources universally accessible through physical means
- An integrated, **Open & Inclusive Digital Library** could make educational resources accessible to **anyone**, **anytime**, **anywhere**
- 3 Digitization allows for long-term preservation of knowledge heritage
- Digital Libraries serve as an easily updatable multi-format trove of continual knowledge for both current and future generations




