### CONDITIONS

The applicant must

- be an Australian citizen or have been a permanent resident of Australia for at least two years and be committed to remain in Australia for at least six years. (DL seminars are not intended for native speakers)
- be committed to **teaching German in Australia for another six years**
- be a teacher of German at a primary, secondary or tertiary institution in Australia (for target groups see above table)
- have a very good knowledge of German, i.e. be able to easily follow lectures and participate in discussions in German (DL courses see above table)
- have a minimum of three years teaching experience
- be prepared to actively participate in the entire program and pass on what they have learned from this course to colleagues in Australia
- not have received a scholarship to the Federal Republic of Germany in the last two years (2018-2020)
- regularly participate in PD seminars and workshops offered by Goethe-Institut Australia
- **be willing to accept that the scholarship will be either held in a face-to face seminar (in Germany) or in a digital format (online).**

### AIMS AND CONTENT (detailed information at <http://www.goethe.de/fortbildung/>)

#### Teaching Methods and Socio-Cultural Studies Scholarships:

Participants have the opportunity to update their socio-cultural knowledge of Germany and to review methodological and didactical issues in the teaching of German as a foreign language. In addition to attending a series of lectures, participants will discover the city on special assignments, visit institutions, note observations and ask questions. Discussions with German people provide an opportunity to refresh German language skills and expand the understanding of the geography, history and institutions of Germany. Experts will inform on the current state of German as a foreign language. The seminars aim to foster the exchange of ideas and the development of teaching models in a group setting. The courses also offer a cultural program.

#### Professional Development Facilitators Scholarships

This program offers an overview of specialized aspects of foreign language learning and the opportunity for an international exchange of experience with colleagues and experts. It also offers development of sequential modules for advanced training and seminar teaching observation. Aims are updating & extending seminar-didactical knowledge for the basic and advanced training of DaF teachers; development and maintenance of professional development expertise; development and presentation of modules for advanced training; meeting in international groups and exchange of expert assessments within the group and with German specialists.

### THE SCHOLARSHIP INCLUDES

- seminar fee, all seminar documents, teaching resources and materials
- accommodation in single room (mostly with a private host, depending on course location). Please note that the amount for accommodation is not redeemable in cash if you decide to make your own arrangement.
- breakfast for the duration of the seminar and cost for public transport if applicable
- one main meal (lunch) on course days (not Saturdays, Sundays or public holidays)
- Extensive cultural program in the evenings and on weekends, e.g. theatre, cinema, concerts, exhibitions, excursions, social events
- a travel allowance of 800 € on arrival in Germany (excluding seminars of one week duration) if the seminar is held face-to-face in Germany
- basic health insurance for the duration of the course (arrival day to departure day; does not cover pre-existing health issues & pregnancy)

Please note: the program of the seminar will be quite demanding and the schedule will keep you busy even at some evenings and at weekends.

### SUCCESSFUL APPLICANTS

- will be notified whether they have received a scholarship at least 10 weeks before the commencement of the course
- must be prepared to participate in the course program regularly
- cannot travel with family members as this would jeopardize the course objectives
- must inform us well in time if they do want to arrange their own accommodation, otherwise there is a minimum of 20% cancellation fee of the accommodation.
- must be prepared to pass on knowledge gained to colleagues back home
- are required to write a short report about the seminar for Goethe-Institut within 4 weeks of their return (half to one page)
- **are willing to accept that the scholarship will be either held in a face-to face seminar (in Germany) or in a digital format (online).**

### APPLICATION PROCEDURE

1. **Check first with your school authority** (eg. DET, AIS, Catholic Education etc.) if any additional forms are required, if the application should be sent to the authority first and **by which date** or if a copy of the email is sufficient.
2. **Complete online the electronic pdf form** "[Bewerbungsformular/Application Form](#)" and follow the instructions on the screen, complete the form and email to us.
3. **Describe in about 150 words** why you are applying for a scholarship in Germany and forward this text together with the application form.
4. Send/email or fax us a **letter of support** from your principal.
