

Conditions of Participation

1. General Requirements

The participants must be at least 15 years of age and cannot be over 17 years of age at the time of the online convention (23 April 2021).

2. Application, Selection and Participation

Application is open between 31 January 2021 and 15 March 2021. The Goethe-Institut will select six students to represent the team Australia at dareCon! from 23 April to 25 April 2021. By the End of March, the Goethe-Institut contacts the applicants to inform them if they were successful or not. The successful applicants will be sent an official enrollment form.

3. Cancellation

As soon as the participants have officially registered, their participation is binding. They can only cancel their participation with good reason. The cancellation must be made in writing or by e-mail.

4. Costs

Participation at the dareCon! is free of charge.

5. Digital Device

Participants need a computer, laptop or tablet that is connected to the internet and equipped with a camera, microphone and headphones. For some workshops you also need a mouse and a smartphone. The workshops will take place on zoom. 6. Teacher's Consent

The participants are required to inform their teacher of German about their application. A letter of support from this teacher must be added in the application.

7. Code of Conduct

Participants take note of and agree that in the event of serious violations of the rules of netiquette (e.g. anti-social behaviors) they will be excluded from the event.

8. Privacy

Participants agree that all transmitted data and information will be electronically stored and processed by the Goethe-Institut. If necessary, the data will also be made available to dareCon! partner organisations. The transfer of the data is in our interest as well as in the interest of the participants as it serves to ensure that they are adequately cared for. The data will always be kept confidential.

9. Liability

The parents/guardians assume full liability for the students during the entire duration of the convention. The Goethe-Institut, its employees or persons acting on its behalf cannot be made liable for any damages that may arise in connection with the participation. Instead, the parents/guardians shall bear the costs of such damages. This does not apply to damage resulting from gross negligence or intentional actions of an employee of the Goethe-Institut or person acting on its behalf.
