EU4Culture is the EU-funded project. The project targets the cultural and creative sector in the Eastern Partnership countries, aiming to support the development of culture as an engine for growth and social development across the region.

EU4Culture makes particular focus on non-capital cities and towns of the region. The project will assist non-capital cities in Armenia, Azerbaijan, Georgia, the Republic of Moldova, and Ukraine to develop and implement a Cultural Development Strategy. The selected cities or towns will receive capacity building support in the fields of internationalisation, cultural enterprise and management, and cultural indicators and statistics. In addition, a grant scheme for cultural projects, cross-innovation projects, festivals, as well as mobility scheme, will complement the project. The EU4Culture project is implemented by the Goethe-Institut (lead), the Danish Cultural Institute, Czech Centres and the Institut Français in Georgia.
