Definitions Shared:

- Impostor syndrome (psychological pattern in which an individual doubts their skills, talents, or accomplishments and has a persistent internalized fear of being exposed as a "fraud" / Common causes of impostor phenomenon include feelings such as stigma, stereotype threat)
- Tokenism (practice of making only a perfunctory or symbolic effort to be inclusive to members of minority groups)
