Space: The space is 11m by 7m with a 5m-high ceiling. The floor is linoleum over concrete so is suitable for some dance rehearsal but not all. Some furniture can be provided on request.

Light and Sound: The space has dimmable lighting and natural light from windows along one long side. Natural light can be blacked out with blinds. With prior arrangement, a sound system can be available.

Ventilation: The space has an air-ventilation unit which circulate fresh air into the space. It is a current requirement to make use of this to satisfy government guidelines.

Wi-Fi: There is free Wi-Fi throughout the building, please contact reception for login details.

Access: The Goethe-Institut London is an accessible building. Please make us aware of any access requirements during the booking process.

Opening times: Our general opening times are between 9am and 7pm.

Facilities: Bathroom facilities are located on the Basement level. There is a vending Machine and a water fountain on level 2 outside our classrooms. Catering can be arranged directly with Stein's Berlin Café and Restaurant who are located on the ground floor.

Security: The Goethe-Institut London building is open to the public. Please be aware to lock the space when you are not using it. You can be let back in at any time by our reception staff. There are lockers available on level 1 in the library if you want to store valuables. All property brought onto the premises remains your responsibility and is used at your own risk.
