COVID-19 Rules & Regulations

Requirements for all the course or examination participants who will enter the premises of Max Mueller Bhavan New Delhi.

Any ONE of the following three requirements needs to be fulfilled:

- Vaccinated (complete, i.e. 2 x vaccinations)
- Recovered (less than 6 months in the past)
- Tested (a current RTPCR test, not older than 72 hours)

ID-Proof (original Aadhar-Card or passport).

No photocopies will be accepted. Admission may be denied if any of the prerequisites are not met.

Final vaccination certificate with both the doses/negative RT-PCR Report/positive and negative Covid-19 report in case of recovery.

Information for Candidates

Before arrival

Please check our website/your E-Mail before leaving home. In case of rising infections the institute may have to cancel the exam without prior notice.

The Goethe-Institut / Max Mueller Bhavan is still closed for general public. Only exam candidates with a scheduled exam are allowed into the premises.

Please appear for your exam only if you are not feeling sick and have not been showing any symptoms of an infection in the days before the exam, and if you have not been in contact with an ill person.

You are expected to report to the exam centre wearing a mask, and carrying your own water bottle and food. Our cafeteria is not open for the general public at the moment. You may carry extra protection such as face-shield and gloves.

Arrival at the Institute

Please arrive at least 30 minutes before the exam starts

Only the candidate will be allowed to enter the institute's premises. No waiting area will be unfortunately provided to accompanying people.

Upon arrival at the institute, please disinfect your hands.

Our staff will record your temperature at the entrance and multiple times while you are inside, if required.

A self-declaration document declaring your current health status with respect to COVID-19 is enclosed. Please handover the same duly signed at the entrance.

Inside the Institute

Bags and other luggage will not be allowed into the premises. Kindly bring only a small bag along to carry your documents and other belongings.

You will be asked to place the bag in an allocated space inside the premises.

Do not carry any stationery and valuables. You will be provided with pens in the examination hall.

Wrist-watches will not be allowed in the examination hall.

Please enter the building only by the marked path and follow the instructions.

You are expected to maintain a distance of two meters from other exam candidates and staff. Hand sanitizers are placed at various locations inside the premises. Please disinfect your hands frequently, before and after the exam and please refrain from touching other surfaces unnecessarily.

You are expected to wear a mask during the entire time. You may be requested to remove this for a short while only for confirming your identity. Avoid frequently touching the mask and your face.

In case you feel uneasy, please inform the exam supervisor immediately.

There is a designated bin for disposing masks and tissue towels and you are requested not to throw such materials elsewhere.

Candidates are requested to move around only in the allowed spaces in the premises.
