He drills holes in the wood.

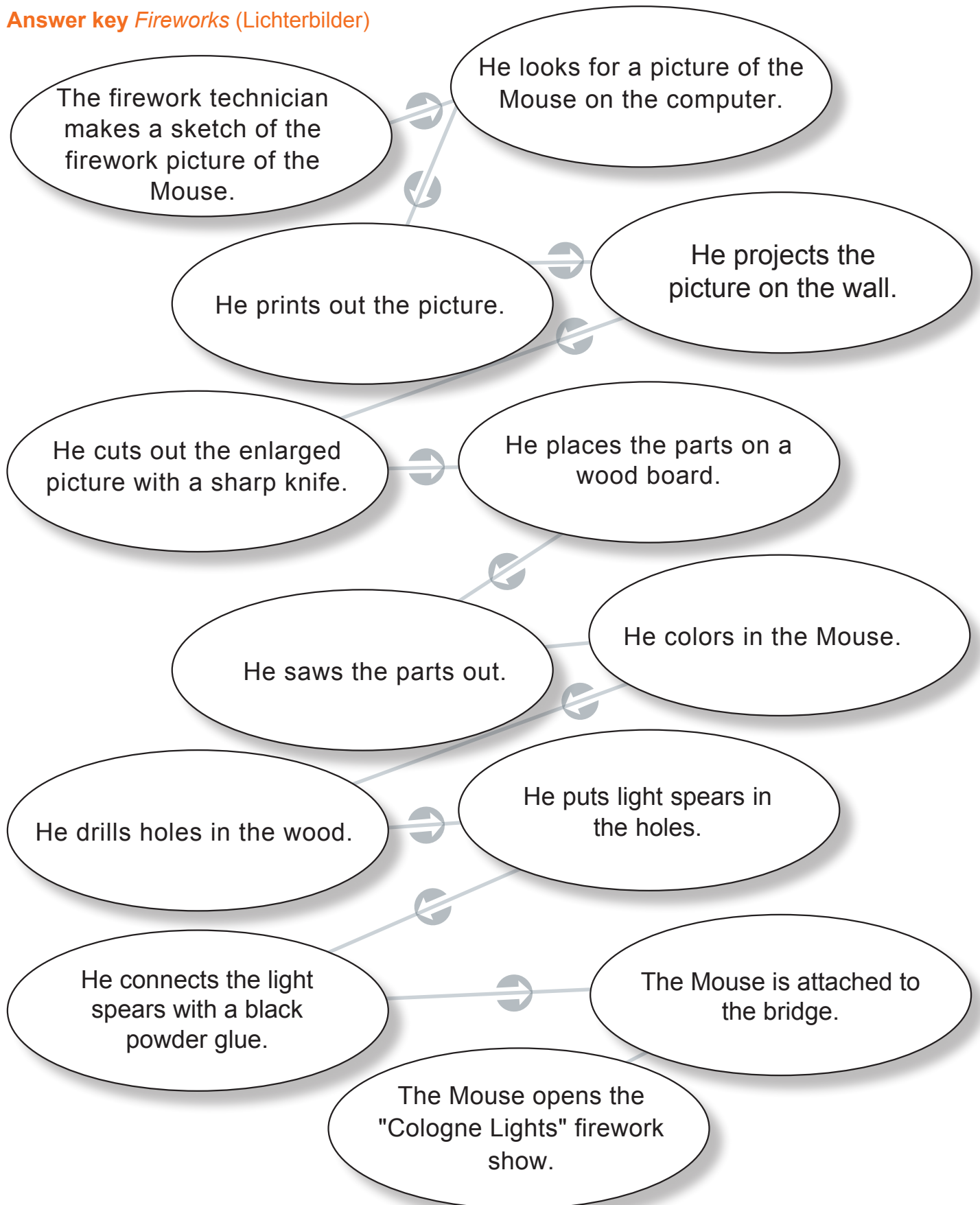

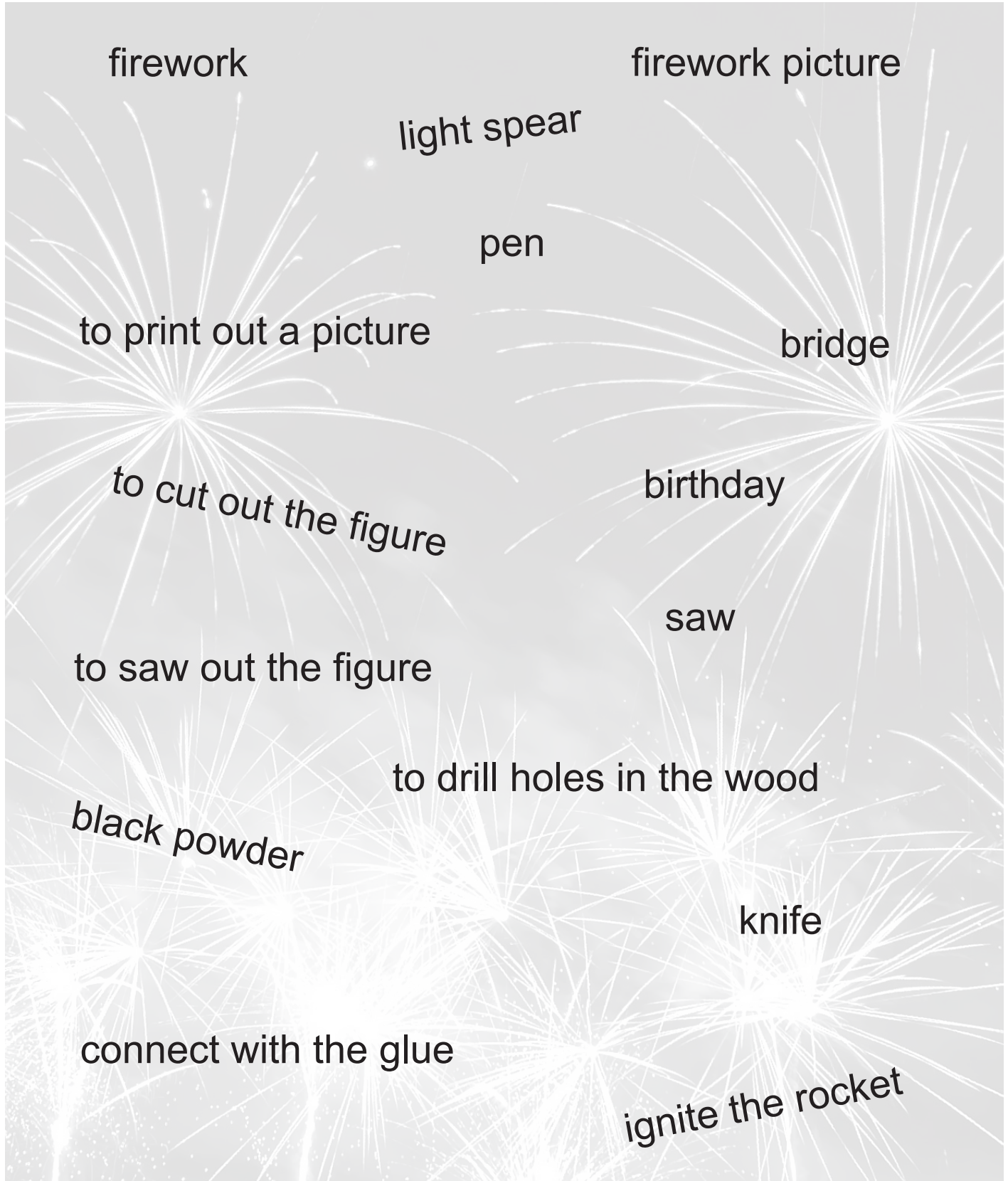
