

Resonate Opus II

Gewandhausorchester Musicians and Filipino multimedia artist, Jett Ilagan, aka escuri, perform Kurtág's 6 Moments musicaux Op. 44 for String Quartet

In this second installment in the online concert series, *Resonate*, musicians from the *Gewandhausorchester Leipzig* combine with Filipino multimedia artist, *Jett Ilagan* aka escuri, to create 6 video clips of Kurtág's 6 *Moments musicaux Op. 44*. Filmed in the historic Moritzbastei underground club in Leipzig, sound and visuals by Jett Ilagan reinterpret Kurtág's music specially for a digital audience.

The online series **Resonate** presents collaborations between Musicians of the Gewandhausorchester and artists in the **Leipzig International Art Programme (LIA)**. During each **Resonate** collaboration, the guest LIA artist creates a visual response to the live music performance. The founder of Resonate, **Tahlia Petrosian**, describes this innovative format as "exploring both the interaction between music and art and the potential to re-interpret concert formats for a digital audience".

The 6 video clips in this collaboration will be released online on **March 7, 2022** across **Resonate** social media platforms and will also available to view free on **www.resonate.live**.
