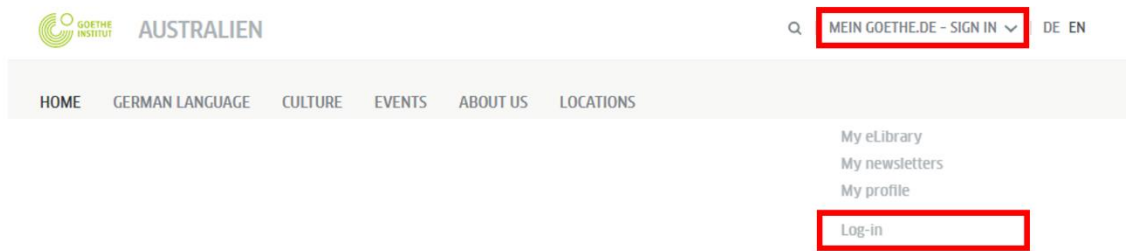


Instructions for Registering and Signing-In at Mein Goethe.de

1. You can access the Goethe-Institut's virtual portal by clicking Log-In at www.goethe.de.



This will take you to the registration and log in page. If this is your first time on the website click on **REGISTER**.

2. Enter your email address, password and country/region. Confirm your registration by clicking **REGISTER**.

3. You will then see confirmation of your successful registration:

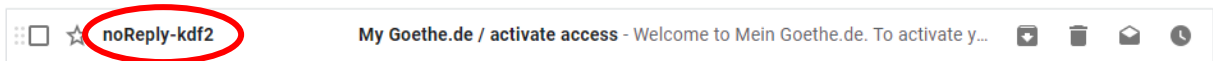

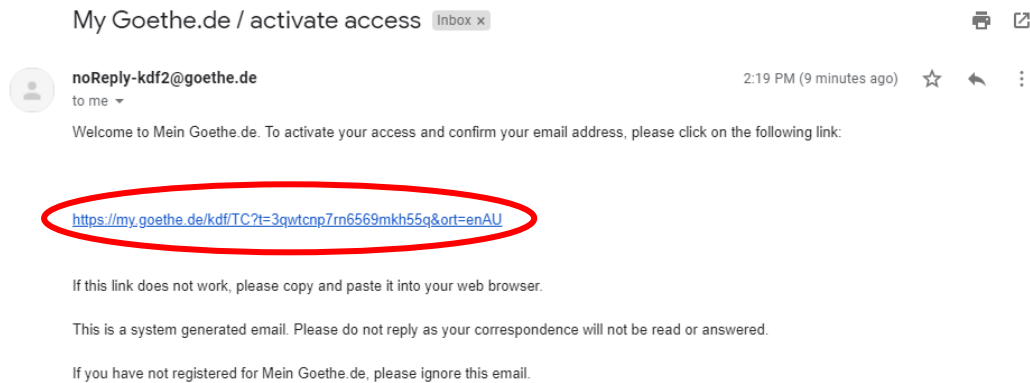

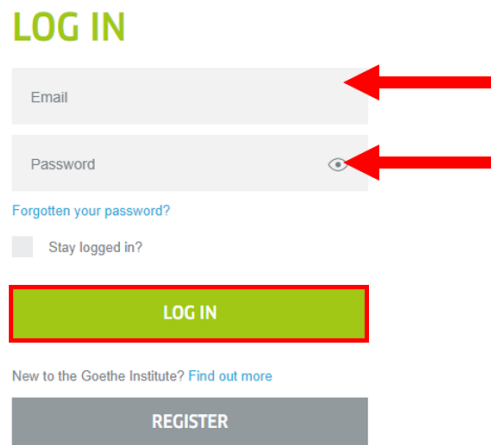
4. Check your inbox for an email from ,noReply-kdf'.



5. Open the email with the subject ,Mein Goethe.de/activate access' and click on the provided confirmation link.



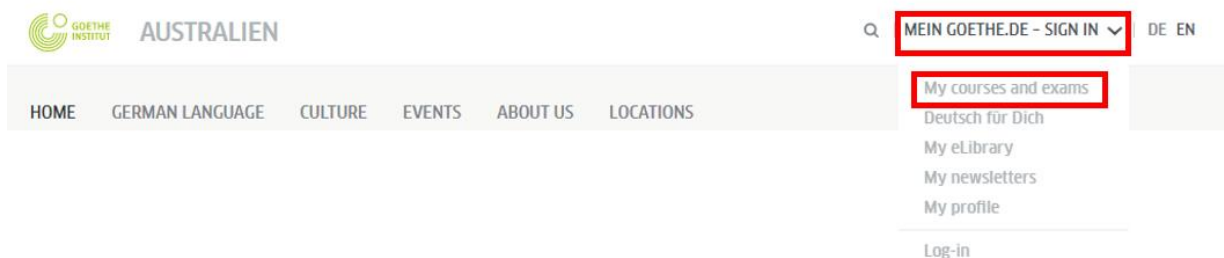
6. The link will open the same registration and log in page as before. This time enter your email address and password, and then click **LOG IN**.



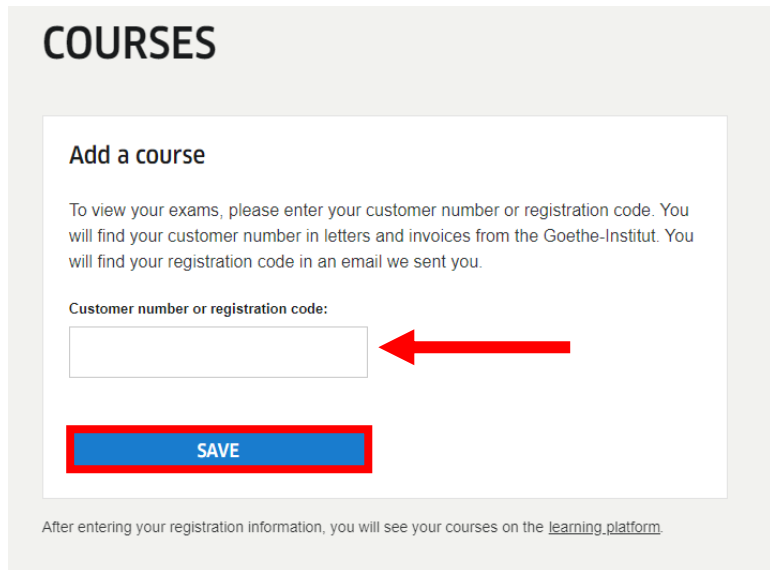
7. In the top right corner you can choose your preferred language...



...then click ,**Mein Goethe.de**' and ,**My Courses and Exams**'.

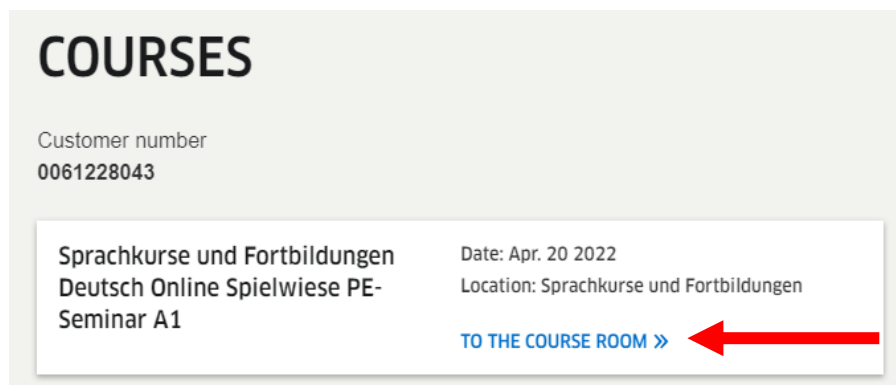


8. You will be taken to the **,COURSES'** page...

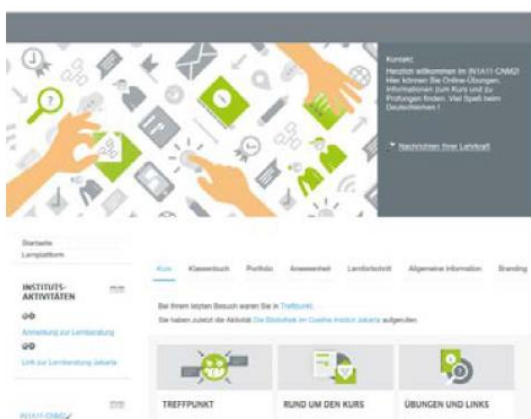


Under which it will say **,Add a course'** with a space for you to type in a **,Customer number or registration code'**. Enter your Customer Number here, which you will have received in an email from the Language Course Department when you registered for the course. Your customer number begins with 006 (e.g. 0060123456).

9. After clicking **,SAVE'** you will see a confirmation of your registration and the link to your course. Click on **,TO THE COURSE ROOM'** in order to sync your account to **,Mein Goethe.de'**.
