ACTIVITY 1: HABITATS

Overview

Use the ecosystems <u>Poster "Wadden Sea"</u> to explore the habitats of the *Wattenmeer*, and identify the biotic and abiotic factors that make up the ecosystem.

Instructions

- 1. Analyze the poster.
- 2. Identify the different habitats in the park.
- Make note of the species found in each habitat. You may need to make inferences if a species is shown in habitat, but not labeled in that habitat. Use clues in the poster to name the unidentified animals.
- 4. Show your observations in the digital format of your teacher's choice.
- 5. Share your observations digitally with your group members and/or whole class.
- 6. Using examples from the poster, apply the vocabulary terms by identifying the biotic and abiotic factors of the *Wattenmeer* ecosystem.

Vocabulary

Biotic factor: A living or once living component of an ecosystem such as an animal or plants. *Abiotic factor*: A nonliving component of an ecosystem such as ocean salinity or temperature.
