Dr Rohini Rau is India's former top woman sailor. Her best World ISAF Ranking was 94 and 5th in Asia. She created history by winning India's first international gold medal by a women's youth team at the Asian Sailing Championship in 2004. She has participated in 9 World Championships, winning 6 international medals and 32 National Medals including 8 Consecutive National titles in the Laser Radial. She campaigned for the 2012 Olympic Games.

She completed her medical degree (MBBS) at Chengalpet Govt. Medical College and her MSc Internal Medicine (University of Edinburgh). She worked as a Senior Resident Doctor at Kauvery Hospital, Chennai. She is a certified Functional Medicine Practitioner (AFMCP) by Institute of Functional Medicine, USA 2021 and has begun her own practice.

She is the Outgoing Curator of the Chennai Hub Global Shapers Community (an initiative of the World Economic Forum) and a 2009 TED Fellow.

Rohini is India's first Medical Clown and trainer. She has worked with The Little Theatre's Hospital Clowns Troupe since 2015. She heads the cEnter for Creative Therapy by The Little Theatre at the Government Childrens Hospital, Chennai.

He is an alumnus of the Global Shapers Community, an initiative of the World Economic Forum, (2012). He was a panelist at the World Economic Forum on India 2012. He is a TEDx speaker, a trained martial artist and a fitness enthusiast.

Since 2007 he has created, written, produced, directed and acted in numerous critically acclaimed and commercially successful theatre productions, with over 20 original home productions by The Little Theatre. His shows played in Iran and Malaysia to standing ovations.

He is one of the few privileged Indians to have performed at United Nations, New York. His most recent work is in the film "Rocketry" which is an international multilingual film directed by the Bollywood actor R. Madhavan. Divakar holds post graduate and research degrees in music, from the University of Glamorgan. He is also attached to the Skillset Screen Academy, Wales, member of the British Forum for Ethnomusicology and the Association of British Scholars in India.



Pa Ranjith
Director & Producer Tamil Film Industry
(Neelam Productions)

Pa Ranjith, a fine arts graduate from Government College of Fine Arts, started his career in films working as an assistant director in four feature length films. After his period as an assistant director he wrote and directed his first feature length film named 'ATTAKATHI - 2012' which was appreciated for its light heartedness yet genuine portrayal of subaltern culture, a very rare element in the mainstream. The film went on to become a commercial success.

Then it was 'MADRAS' in 2014. Madras was a high voltage drama with a strong political overtone. The film was praised by critics and audience alike for its emotional appeal and lively portrayal of characters and North Madras landscape which till then was shown in mainstream as an area of shady criminals and dehumanizing violence.

'KABALI' - 2016 which starred Rajnikanth in the lead role was a stylish gangster story set in Malaysia. It had a strong social commentary about the sub culture and oppressed classes among the Tamils in Malaysia. The film earned critical acclaim and was a box office blockbuster.

After the success of Kabali, Ranjith and Rajnikanth collaborated again for KAALA which released in 2018. Kaala was set in Dharavi – Mumbai one of the largest slums in the world, telling the story of Karikaalan who ultimately leads his fellow residents, who are being tormented by greedy corporate builders, to struggle to retain the land that they created.

Apart from writing and directing films Ranjith is also a socially committed artist who has produced documentaries. LADIES AND GENTLEWOMEN (a documentary on the lesbian history of Tamilnadu) DR.SHOE MAKER (about a dedicated sports shoe mender), BEWARE OF CASTE (on the Mirchpur violence) are all documentaries he produced. He also produced a play MANJAL (The colour yellow) a play on manual scavenging.

He is the founder of THE CASTELESS COLLECTIVE - an energetic gaana-rap band giving base to talented artists whose voices weren't heard so powerfully in mainstream. Koogai, a film movement and a library and NEELAM CULTURAL CENTER, a cultural organization are also his ventures that take forward his vision of people's cinema and art. His first film as a Producer was 'Pariyerum Perumal' - 2018 under his banner NEELAM PRODUCTIONS. This film became a huge box office success.



Janaka Pushpanathan Director, British Council, South India

Janaka Pushpanathan currently leads British Council's work in South India, and she has over 25 years of experience in the Arts, Education & Enterprise sectors. Prior to this, she has co-founded education, learning & development, and Ed tech start-ups, which have won the Red Herring Top 100 and the NASSCOM Top 50 awards in the innovation category. Janaka has been a part of British Council's think tank on Intercultural Dialogue and was also the Regional Head of the United States India Education Foundation (USIEF) for South India.

As the Director of British Council in South India, Janaka leads the Council's work, in the five southern states: this includes partnerships with schools and higher education institutions, leading on government to government bilateral relations between UK and India, managing advocacy initiatives for English language teaching & training; working with partners to strengthen the creative economy for arts, crafts, festivals and major programmes in South India and promoting educational and cultural exchange between UK and India through the British Council teaching centre, examinations services and library & information services.
