RULES / REGULATIONS

1. Films made in celluloid or digital format within a running time of max. 30 minutes in the genre of '**short fiction**' and made after 1 January 2020 are eligible for entry. **Documentaries will not be accepted.** Entries will be subject to selection by the Kalpanirjhar Selection Committee.
2. Entries for preview will be accepted in digital version or online transfers only. Last date for receiving entries is **30 September 2022.**
There will be an entry fee of INR 500 (indian rupees five hundred, non-refundable) for **Indian entries only** to be transferred online directly (preferably through NEFT) to the savings bank account of "**Kalpanirjhar Foundation**", at **The South Indian Bank Ltd, Ballygunge Branch, Account number: 0267053000002601, IFS Code: SIBL0000267.**
3. There will be a **Patton Award** carrying a cash prize of INR 20,000 and a trophy for the Best Indian Film and a **Kalpanirjhar Award** carrying a cash prize of INR 10,000 for the Second-Best Indian Film to be selected by a national jury from among the Indian entries selected for the festival. Non-Indian entries cannot compete for these awards. All selected films will get a festival participation laurel.
4. Films made in any language other than English must have English subtitles.
5. The entry form should be filled in legibly, must be complete and accompanied by the details of the online transfer. Incomplete entries will not be considered.
6. The entries should reach us before the last date for submission.
7. Excerpts from selected films may be used for publicity purposes only.
8. Information about selected entries will be individually intimated and also put up on the Kalpanirjhar Foundation website www.kalpanirjhar.com. The selected films will also be featured in the festival brochure.
