FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS: COURSES

When will the online registrations begin for the next Batches?

The online booking for all the levels (A1-C2) will be open as per the enrolment plan on our Website via Webshop (Ref. Registration dates on our website).

Are there any particular qualifications required to join the courses?

There is no particular qualification required to join the courses.

The course aspirant needs to either have the international examination certificate for the previous course level not older than 6 months or should have attended a course of the previous level with us, within the past 6 months. In case the course aspirant does not have either of these, she / he will have to take the level assessment test.

Level Assessment Test

The minimum age criteria to join the courses is 17 years and above.

For Young Learner's Courses: 13 Years and above

What is the difference between extensive, intensive and Superintensive course?

Our extensive and intensive courses normally takes place in face to face and completely online live format on weekdays as well as on the weekends.

WEEKEND COURSES

Extensive

The classes take place on weekends. The duration is 20 weekends.

(*C2 = 25 Weekends)

Intensive (Fasttrack weekend)

The classes take place on weekends. The course duration is 13,5 weekends.

WEEKDAY COURSES

Intensive

The classes take place on weekdays. The course duration is 12 weeks.

Superintensive (Fasttrack weekdays)

The classes take place on weekdays. The course duration is 6,5 weeks.

BLENDED LEARNING COURSES

The classes take place on weekdays (12 weeks) as well as on weekends (20 weekends). You will learn just as much in a blended learning course as in one of our intensive or extensive courses. The learning time per week is divided into two equal parts:

- -Offline group classes
- -Independent online learning: learning on the Moodle platform of the Goethe-Institut

Independent Online Learning

50% of a blended learning course consists of independent online learning. You will have access to our online platform, where you will find the online portion of the course. This section of online learning includes engaging learning activities, online flash cards to study vocabulary, and summary sheets of all important grammatical structures and phrases you will encounter.

Your instructor will assign weekly exercises intended to be completed at your own pace within a given week. These exercises will prepare you for your scheduled online live sessions / Face to face classes in which you will get to interact your coursemates and teachers.

- -The learning material used for these classes is especially designed course material adapted for blended learning.
- -The learning material used for these classes are course books. These could be either in print form or in digital form.

Are the courses offered offline?

Yes, We are currently offering completely face to face classes as well as completely online live classes. Please check the available course levels and formats at the time of registering through the Webshop.

What are the technical requirements?

For attending the online live sessions, you will need the following:

- 1. Computer / Laptop / Tablet / Smart phone
- 2. Internet connection
- 3. Headphones with mic

Is the Fee same for the online courses offered now as the offline classes earlier?

Yes, the fee is same.

What would be the mode of payment?

The courses can be booked online and the payment can be done online via Webshop using Master and Visa Credit cards.

What is a WEBSHOP?

Webshop is an e-commerce platform where you select, book and pay for your courses.

Is study material included in the course fee?

No, the course study material has to be purchased separately.

However the learning material for blended learning courses is included in the course fee.

We have a book shop on our Premises, where the prescribed course books can be purchased. Alternatively the books can also be ordered directly with Goyal Publishers, who are providing home delivery service to deliver the books for a nominal delivery charge.
