

WHAT IS YOUR JOB?

Children ask parents/people from their environment about their professions as homework. The results are presented and discussed in class.



Preperation

- ▶ Copy or print the questionnaire



Learning Objective:

Get to know professions

Grade Level: From 3rd Grade

Duration: 45 minutes

Materials: Questionnaire (second page)



Implementation

1. Distribute the questionnaires.
2. The children take it home and ask their parents or another person in their environment.
3. In the next lesson, the interviews are presented and discussed.



Reflection Suggestions

- ▶ Did the interviewees enjoy talking about their work?
- ▶ Is it important whether the profession is carried out by a woman or a man or does it not matter?
- ▶ If applicable: What do you think about the fact that in the professions presented, only either men or women work?
- ▶ Which professions did you find particularly interesting?
What did you find interesting about them?



Extensions

If possible, invite some of the interviewees to your class and ask them to tell the children even more about their work.

If possible, especially invite adults who work in jobs where their gender is not a majority (male educator/caregiver/florist/full-time dad...; female engineer/firefighter/police officer...).
