"LES AMAZONES" is a play that tells the story of two fighting sisters. Zama and Sone are called upon day and night to provide for their family. Without worrying about the source of the money they receive, the members of their family multiply the requests for help both through letters and through telephone calls. Forced into prostitution since the age of 12, the two sisters engage in a battle for the triumph of love and life.

Selected among a hundred other talents by a jury made up of Jonas Embom (theatre teacher, actor and director), Bertrand Baleguel (actor and theater director) and Lisette Nange (actress and theater director), Laurita Ngringeh offers us a showprepared under the watchful eye of his coaches: Naouele Antonia (Choreographer) and Akumbu Louis Jones Bubuh (director).
