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Exhibition



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Theme: “From Germany into the world” (Classes 6 - 12)

Germany has shaped the world in different ways. The exhibition will circle around the following questions: Which German inventions do we use every day? Which German products are known all over the world? Which German personalities have helped shape world history?

Each participating school will be given a selected topic. Students are supposed to research about it and present it in an interactive way. The purpose of the exhibition is to emphasize the way how Germany is present in all our daily lives.

Participation: 4 students per school (Classes 6 - 12) and 1 teacher.

Each participating school will be allotted a stall for putting up their exhibits.

Below are the further details

- Stall size: Stall will be covered from three sides. (Size: Length 3 m X Width 3 m X Height 8 ft.)
- Interactive Game: The stall must put up at least one game (in German language, based on the theme) with non-monetary prizes to be won.
- Other resources: One table with table cover and two chairs, stall with PVC wall will be provided.
- No pin boards will be provided. The kids can carry their pasting material along.



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Competitions



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Fashion Show: Germany meets India (Classes 4-5)

Contest Format:

- It is an individual performance.
- The school should send one participant from above mentioned classes.
- Time allotted to each participant: max. 2 minutes.
- The participant has to display an outfit combining German and Indian fashion.
- The participant has to do a walk on the stage and speak about his/her outfit in 3-5 sentences in German.
- The 1st - 3rd prize winner will be required to perform on stage during the closing ceremony.
- Criteria of Judgement: Theme, Creativity, Presentation, Language.

Deutschland-Quiz (Classes 6-8)

Contest Format:

- Schools to send a team of 3 students.
- The participant have to answer questions related to Germany in different rounds of difficulty.
- Teams should come prepared with general knowledge about Germany.
- The winners will be given a prize during the final ceremony.

Spell-Bee (Classes 9-10)

Contest Format:

- It is an individual competition.
- The school should send one participant from above mentioned classes.
- Students have to spell different German words during different rounds of difficulty.
- The winner will be awarded during the final ceremony.

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Design your „Namaste Deutschland“ – T-Shirt (Classes 6-8)

Contest Format:

- The participants have to design a T-Shirt for NAMASTE DEUTSCHLAND related to the topic “from Germany into the world”.
- Schools to send a team of max. 3 students.
- Maximum time to design: 60 minutes.
- The team will be provided with a basic T-Shirt. All other material should be brought by the participants.
- They can use recycled or up-cycled material like newspaper, used ribbons etc.
- The participants then have to present their T-Shirt in front of a jury and quickly explain the idea behind the design.
- Time allotted for each presentation: max. 2 minutes.
- All teams will act as audience while their other counterpart team is presenting.
- The 1st prize winner will be required to present on stage during the final ceremony.
- Criteria of Judgement: Theme, Creativity, Use of recycled material, Presentation.

Stand-Up Comedy (Classes 8-12)

Contest Format:

- Schools to send 1 participant.
- The participant has to present a short comedy performance.
- Maximum time for each performance: 2 minutes.
- The participant is required to use German language only.
- The jokes should be related to the theme “from Germany into the world” or “Germany & India”.
- The 1st prize winner will perform during the final ceremony.
- Criteria of judgement: Humor, Theme, Presentation, Confidence.



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Competitions



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Table Tennis Tournament (Classes 6-8)

Contest Format:

- Schools to send 2 students, one girl and one boy, for a mixed double.
- Equipment will be provided.
- Teams will compete in different rounds.
- The winning team will be awarded during the final ceremony.

Knock-Out Basketball (Classes 6-8)

Contest Format:

- Schools to send 2 students, one boy and one girl for a basketball competition.
- Students will compete in the game called “Knock-Out” in which they have to score points and eliminate the other players.
- Boys and girls will be competing in different games.
- The two winners will be awarded in the final ceremony.

Paint your canvas – My Germany (Classes 7-8)

Contest Format

- Schools to send 2 students.
- All necessary items are provided.
- Students need to paint on the topic “My Germany”.
- The best painting will be awarded during the final ceremony.

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How Germany shaped our daily life! Online Video-Competition (Classes 9-12)

Contest Format

- This is an Online-Competition only.
- School to choose 2 students from above mentioned classes.
- Participants have to create a video on the topic: How Germany shaped our daily life!
- The video shall not be longer than 3 minutes.
- The deadline to send in the video is 11.11.2022!
- The best video will be shown and awarded during the event.



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Workshops

Two sessions each of the following workshops of 90 minutes.

Junioruni (Classes 9-12)

- The students will get to know the interactive and free learning platform “Junioruni”.
- Maximum 30 participants per workshop.
- Max. 2 participants per school on first-come-first-served basis.

Story-Time with the Brothers Grimm (Classes 4-5)

- The students will get to know the fairytales of the famous writers Jacob and Wilhelm Grimm with games and fun activities.
- Maximum 30 participants per workshop.
- Max. 2 participants per school on first-come-first-served basis.

My country is your country – India meets Germany (Classes 6-8)

- This workshop will compare the life in India and Germany and will help students gaining intercultural skills.
- Maximum 30 participants per workshop.
- Max. 2 participants per school on first-come-first-served basis.

Spielzeit – Time to play (Classes 6-8)

- The students will get to know and play typical German games and interact with the other students.
- Maximum 30 participants per workshop.
- Max. 2 participants per school on first-come-first-served basis.



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Workshops



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German Inventions (Classes 6-7)

- In this workshop students playfully learn about inventions from Germany that have changed the world.
- Maximum 30 participants per workshop.
- Max. 2 participants per school on first-come-first-served basis.

Poetry-Slam (Classes 9-12)

- In this workshop students will learn how much fun is hidden in the German Language and how easy it is to create a small poem.
- Maximum 30 participants per workshop.
- Max. 2 participants per school on first-come-first-served basis.

With wandering words through the world (Classes 8-9)

- This workshop participants will discover words that emigrated from German and learn how German as a language found its new home in other places of the world.
- Maximum 30 participants per workshop.
- Max. 2 participants per school on first-come-first-served basis.



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Workshops



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Zumba (Classes 6-8)

- In this workshop students will move to the sound of German music.
- Maximum 30 participants per workshop.
- Max. 2 participants per school on first-come-first-served basis.

Drama Drama (Classes 9-12)

- This workshop will give students the opportunity to step on stage and become a performer by improving verbal and non-verbal communication skills.
- Maximum 30 participants per workshop.
- Max. 2 participants per school on first-come-first-served basis.



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Interactive Info-Session (Classes 9 - 12)

- Topic: Higher Studies in Germany
- School to send a maximum of 5 students.
- Resource Person: expert from DAAD (German Academic Exchange Service)

Film Screening (Classes 8 - 10)

- The name of the film will be announced soon.
- A German film will be screened.
- Max. 5 students per school.

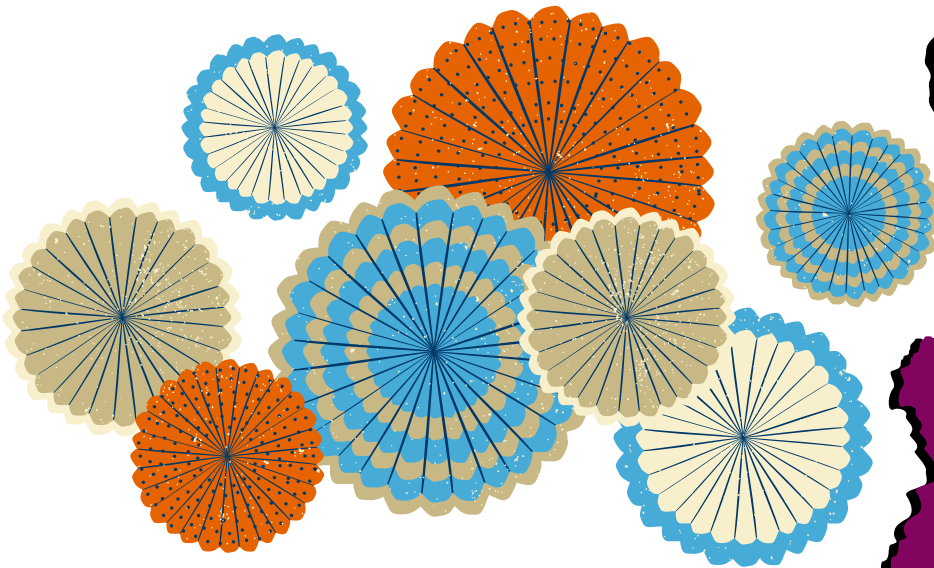


General Instructions
