


REPORT NGŨ HÀNH SƠN INSCRIPTIONS CONDITION

IN GENERAL

In the process of data collection and preservation of the written Nom script in the monitoring area, our research team has only counted about 90 inscriptions scattered in 05 caves: Tang Chon, Huyen Khong, Van Thong, Linh Nham, Am Phu and some other locations. Huyen Khong cave has 59 inscriptions, Tang Chon cave has 20 inscriptions, Linh Nham cave has 03 inscriptions, Van Thong cave has 02 inscriptions, Am Phu cave has 03 inscriptions and the others have 03 inscriptions. Of which, only 79 inscriptions were taken and surveyed in the two largest caves, Huyen Khong and Tang Chan. Other areas cannot be surveyed due to lack of equipment and financial constraints.



According to a preliminary survey of 76 inscriptions at Huyen Khong and Tang Chan caves, there are only 31 inscriptions in full readable condition (accounting for 40.79%), 33 inscriptions with partially or completely eroded (accounting for 43 %), 5 inscriptions were damaged such as chisels etching on documents, writing overlaid on documents (accounted for 6.58%), 14 inscriptions were damaged due to wrong restoration such as painting over, chiseling and overlapping documents (accounting for 18.42%).

INSCRIPTIONS IN HUYEN KHONG CAVE



Huyền không Cave

Huyen Khong cave is one of two caves located on Thuy Son mountain, the highest one in the Marble Mountains. Huyen Khong cave is openair, has a round arch, a flat base, and has five holes in the arch to connect with the outside. During the day, sunlight floods in. That fanciful shimmer has made the cave one of the attractions with the highest spiritual value here.

The entrance to the cave has an archway with the name carved on Huyen Khong Quan, the

gate is a bit narrow, the steps are quite deep, there are statues of *Defenders of the Justice (Dharma)* in the middle of the cave, a reminder for people to give up wrong thoughts when they arrive at the sacred Buddha's door.

Inside the cave is an upside-down bell. At the top is the statue of Shakyamuni Buddha, made in 1960 by artist Nguyen Chat, who is famous in Non Nuoc stone art village. Below is the altar of Ksitigarbha Bodhisattva. On the left side of the cave, there is a temple to Ms. Ngoc Phi (Mrs. Chua Tien); Temple of Loi Phi (Lord Thuong Thousand). Deep right is the ancient Trang Nghiem Tu temple built in 1825, consisting of three compartments. The main hall worships Buddha, the left side worships 3 saints (including Quan Cong, Quan Binh and Chau Xuong) symbolizing virtue, wisdom and loyalty. In particular, the right room worships Ong To and Ba Nguyet, where couples come to pray for love and hope that Nguyet Lao will tie the pink thread for a hundred years of happiness.

¹ Short bio: Tiểu Cao Nguyễn Văn Mại (1858-1945) was a famous poet, politician of the Nguyen Dynasty. He used to govern Quang Nam province, and was instrumental in the development of education in this area during his rule. This is a rare Nom poem carved on stone in Vietnam, and the only song of Ca Tru discovered in South Central Vietnam (Ca Tru is a unique performance genre found only in the North of Vietnam). This document is the only one, a copy has not been found in other forms.

¹³ Cao Xuân Dục was born in Thịnh Mỹ, Diễn Châu, Nghệ An. In 1876, he entered Vietnamese Imperial examination and was awarded the degree of provincial graduate (舉人 - cử nhân), in the same class with the famous anti-French patriot Phan Đình Phùng from Hà Tĩnh.

He served under the Nguyễn Emperors Đồng Khánh and Thành Thái and held several important government posts including Governor-General of Hưng Yên (1889) and minister of education (1907). He was one of the four top advisers to the Emperor during the Vietnam-France conflict in the early 20th century.


IV. INSCRIPTION IN TÀNG CHƠN CAVE

Tang Chon cave has an area of about 10x7m including 3 caves and 3 caverns

From the outside in, through a natural stone archway is Linh Dong Chon Tien Temple. The temple was built in the 6th year of Minh Mang, the form of the temple is similar to Trang Nghiem pagoda in Huyen Khong cave. The temple has 3 worship halls: the middle room worships the stone statue of Buddha Shakyamuni (formerly worshiping Thai Thuong Lao Quan), the right room worships Linh Son Thanh Mau - a gray-brown sandstone goddess statue, with a typical style for Champa visual arts, worshiping Tam Da and Bat Tien.

The cave has about 20 inscriptions


