
VII. CAMPAIGN PLATFORM



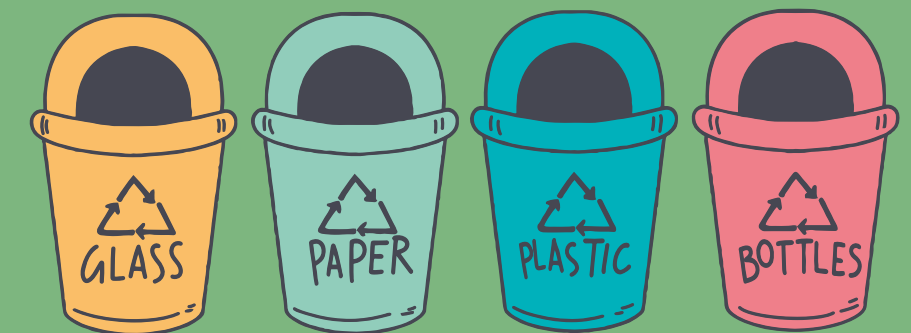
Objectives

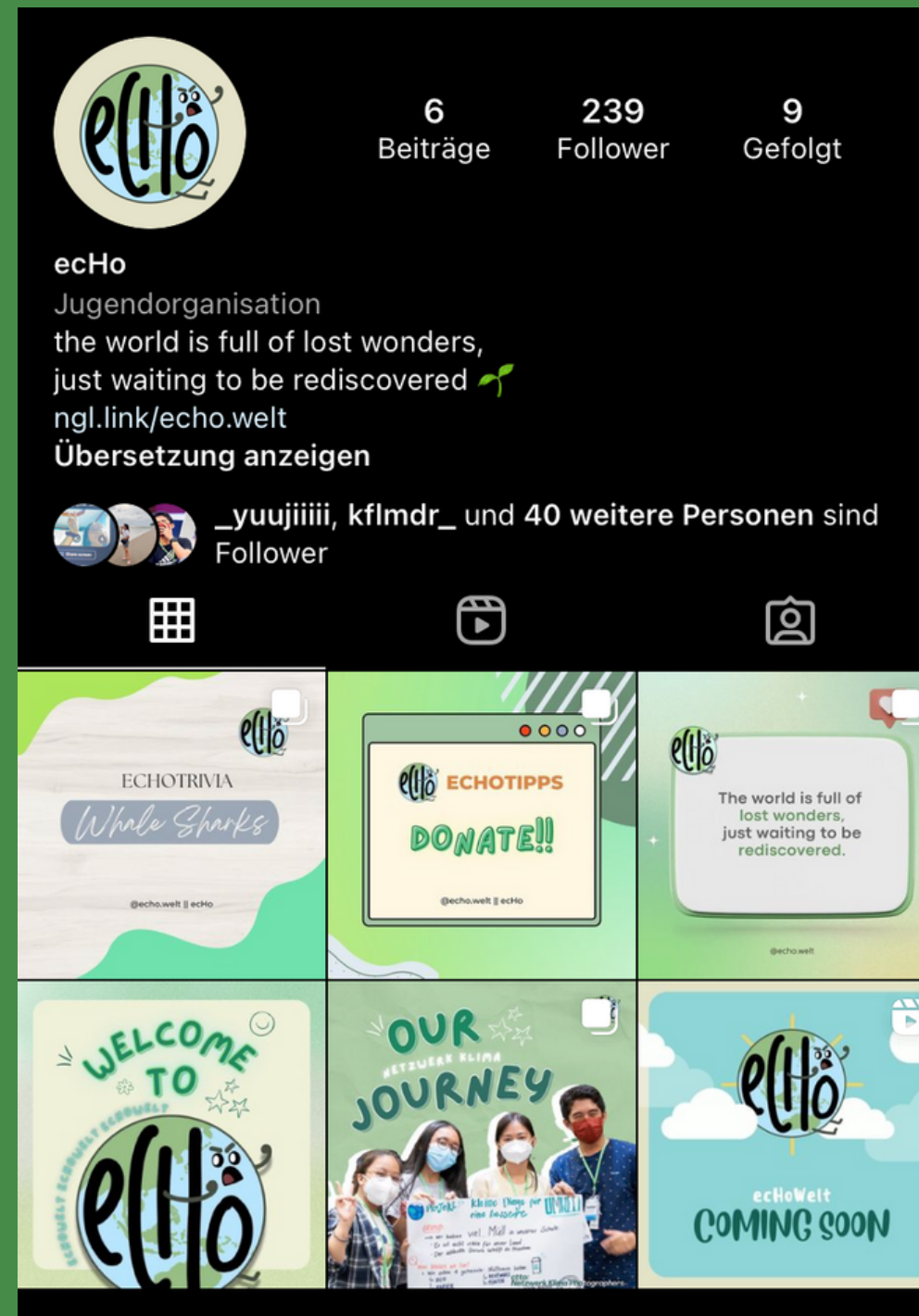

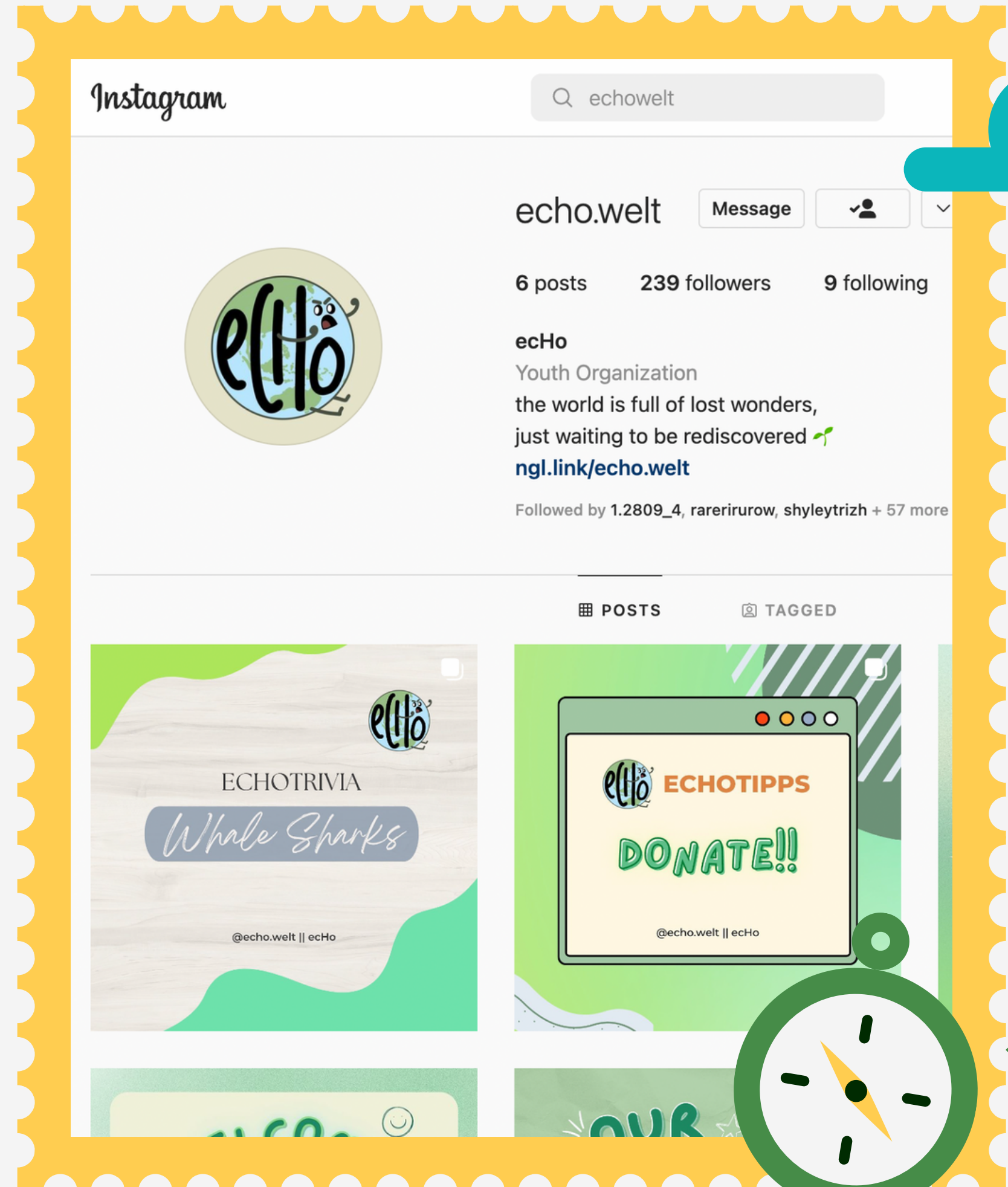

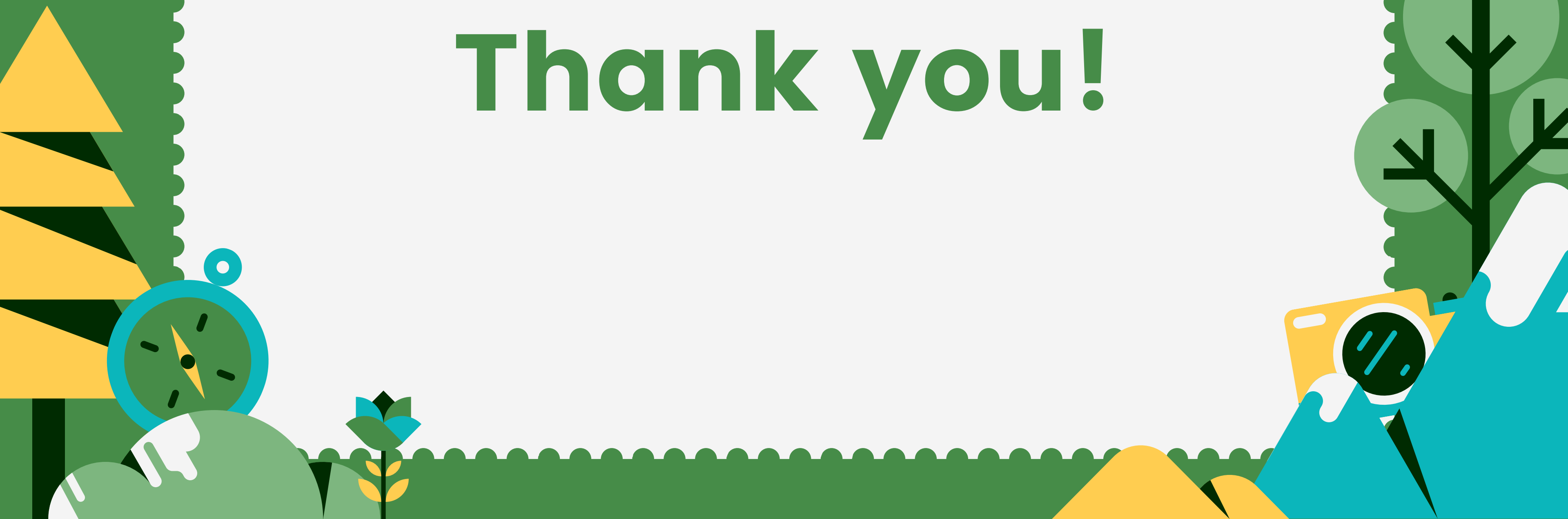
