

### STEM Workshops

The experience stalls are interactive learning stations where participants can engage in hands-on activities related to various STEM (science, technology, engineering, and math) fields. Each stall provides a unique experience and can be completed within 20 minutes, allowing participants to rotate between different stalls throughout the session. Here's a brief introduction to each stall:

**Nao Robot:** Participants can interact with a humanoid robot, Nao, by giving voice commands, making it walk, and recognizing their faces.



**Simple Machines & Robotics Booth:** Participants can view and operate working models related to robotics, including a mini amusement park, an elephant model, and a stair climber that demonstrate simple machines.

**3D Designing & Printing:** Participants can see 3D printers in action and participate in a DIY activity to create 3D badges using 3D doodlers.

**Electronics & IoT:** Participants can view various working electronic circuits and devices, including a cliff-avoiding robot, a smart lamp, and an electric vehicle, as well as renewable energy models.

**DIY Stalls:** Participants can engage in various DIY activities such as creating electronics with copper tapes, building geometrical structures, and making 3D structures using molecular models.

**Drone Area:** Participants can learn how to control drones and experience the thrill of flying within a designated drone cage.

**STEM Games:** Participants can program and solve table-top robotics games - Robothon and Maze Challenge - that involve programming a robot to complete tasks and navigating a ball through a maze using a remote control.




