In celebration of the **75th founding anniversary of Quezon City**, the city is hosting the International PINK Film Festival (IPF) this week, which features contemporary national and international lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender (LGBT) films. The **Quezon City International PINK Film Festival (QCIPFF)** is a year-long project and event that promotes awareness, education and the recognition of the LGBT community through film.

Germany is one of the participating countries in this film festival and has two film entries, ***Freier Fall*** (*Free Fall*) directed by Stephan Lacant and ***Von Mädchen und Pferden*** (*Of Girls and Horses*) by Monika Treut. The two actresses of the film *Von Mädchen und Pferden*, **Alissa Wilms** and **Vanida Karun**, kindly accepted our invitation and are attending the festival.
