The German Photo Book Award Exhibition

The Goethe-Institut Philippinen in partnership with the Konrad Adenauer Asian Institute for Journalism of the Ateneo de Manila University opened the exhibition of the **German Photo Book Award** in Manila on November 24!

The exhibition displays around 200 photo books that were nominated for the award. Around 20 of these were selected for the title **GOLD** and **SILVER** by a jury in Germany. The award is announced annually by the German Publishers Association in Baden-Württemberg.

Since 2003 the German Photo Book Award awards extraordinary works of photographers, writers, and publishers, who present a photographic theme exceptionally well. It is one of the most prestigious awards in the context of photography. The books can be submitted in four different categories, ranging from conceptually **artistic picture books**, to **course books in photographic training**, **photo-theoretic- and historical books** and **Coffee Table Books**.

The opening of the exhibition was received very enthusiastically by many students and is now open to the public. Come and join this interesting experience! The exhibition will be on display until **December 13** at the **Rizal Library** from Monday to Saturday between 9am and 5pm. **Admission is free of charge!**
