

Goal

You get to know the other students in the partner class. You can compare your outfit with that of the students in the exchange class.

Language learning goal

You can make statements about your outfit and the outfits of others. You can express which outfit you like and explain why. You can say which outfit you would like to try on.

MY OUTFIT

What is part of your everyday outfit?
What is not? Why is that?

Which outfit do you want to present to the others? Which other students have a style similar to yours?

YOUR ASSIGNMENTS

Write down what you like to wear and what is generally your favorite outfit. Also include details if you'd like, e.g. jewelry, style of hair, etc.

Now take a photo. In the photo you do not show yourself, you just present your outfit. You will send this photo to your teacher.

You now meet with other students virtually. There you introduce yourselves in groups. You provide information about:

- name, age, habits
- interests and leisure activities
- favorite color
- any additional fact about yourself

This information should include one hidden clue about your outfit so that the other students can guess, which outfit might be yours. You collected the photos and now you guess, which outfit suits whom.

If you guess right, this person briefly talks about their favorite outfit.

Compliment the people your teacher assigned you on their outfit and give a reason for your compliment. If you want, you can also write privately to those who have the same style and / or who you would like to "swap" outfits with.
