GENERAL LANGUAGE COURSES

For course participants (16 years and older)

Learn German with the professionals: The Goethe-Institut / Max Mueller Bhavan Bangalore offers you Intensive Weekday, Intensive Weekend and Super Intensive courses. After an individual placement assessment, you will start lessons in the course at the right level for you. If you have no prior knowledge of German, you will automatically start in course level A1.

Course duration: 6 weeks
Start: 2023 - Jan / Mar / May / Jul / Sep / Nov
Frequency: **160 Uls (UI – 45-minute Unit of Instruction)**
5 x 5.33 UI per week for weekday courses
Participants: at least 12, up to a maximum of 24

LEVEL TEST

Through the Level Test, we can determine your level, create learning goals with you, and choose the best course.

All candidates applying for a course higher than the A1 level are required to have an Examination Certificate or a course Participation Certificate of the previous level that is less than 6 months old from a reputed institute from the date of new course registration.

Candidates may be required to take a Level Test in case of the following:

- Possession of a Goethe-Institut Examination Certificate and/or Participation Certificate that is more than 6 months old, or
- Possession of an exam or course participation certificate from any other institute (not recognised by Goethe-Institut).

The Level Test is an online test consisting of 70 multiple-choice questions.

The Level Test is free of charge.

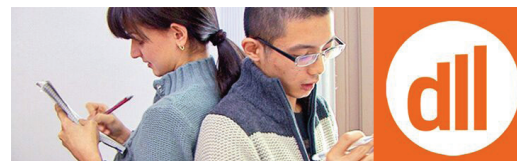
LEARNING GERMAN IN GERMANY

OVERVIEW OF LEVELS

ELEMENTARY USE OF LANGUAGE	A1	Can understand and use familiar, everyday expressions and very simple sentences, which relate to the satisfying of concrete needs. Can introduce him/herself and others as well as ask others about themselves – e.g. where they live, who they know and what they own – and can respond to questions of this nature. Can communicate in a simple manner if the person they are speaking to speaks slowly and clearly and is willing to help.
	A2	Can understand sentences and commonly used expressions associated with topics directly related to his/her direct circumstances (e.g. personal information or information about his/her family, shopping, work, immediate surroundings). Can make him/herself understood in simple, routine situations dealing with a simple and direct exchange of information on familiar and common topics. Can describe his/her background and education, immediate surroundings and other things associated with immediate needs in a simple way.
	B1	Can understand the main points when clear, standard language is used and the focus is on familiar topics associated with work, school, leisure time, etc. Can deal with most situations typically encountered when travelling in the language region. Can express him/herself simply and coherently regarding familiar topics and areas of personal interest. Can report on experiences and events, describe dreams, hopes and goals as well as make short statements to justify or explain his/her own views and plans.
INDEPENDENT LANGUAGE USE	B2	Can understand the main contents of complex texts on concrete and abstract topics; also understands specialized discussions in his/her own primary area of specialization. Can communicate so spontaneously and fluently that a normal conversation with native speakers is easily possible without a great deal of effort on either side. Can express him/herself on a wide range of topics in a clear and detailed manner, explain his/her position on a current issue and indicate the benefits and drawbacks of various options.
AUTONOMOUS LANGUAGE ABILITY	C1	Can understand a wide range of challenging, longer texts and also grasp implicit meanings. Can express him/herself spontaneously and fluently without having to search for words frequently and noticeably. Can use the language effectively and flexibly in his/her social and professional life or in training and studies. Can make clear, structured and detailed statements on complex topics and apply various means of text association appropriately in the process.
	C2	Can effortlessly understand practically everything which he/she reads or hears. Can summarize information from various written and spoken sources, logically recounting the reasons and explanations. Can express him/herself spontaneously with high fluency and precision and also make finer nuances of meaning clear in more complex topics.
