Here are some ideas of questions for you to discuss:**

- *What is there to eat in the restaurant/school cafeteria/diner/cafe?*
- *Why do you like or dislike eating there?*
- *What do you and others like there in particular?*
- *What shouldn't you order?*
- *Are there also vegan or vegetarian food options there?*
- *Who goes there to eat?*
- *Is the place always full?*
- *What is the atmosphere like?*
- *How much do the dishes cost? Is the place on the expensive or on the cheap side?*
- *What should one definitely order there?*
- *What reviews does the place have on the internet?*
- *Would you recommend the place? Why? Why not?*
