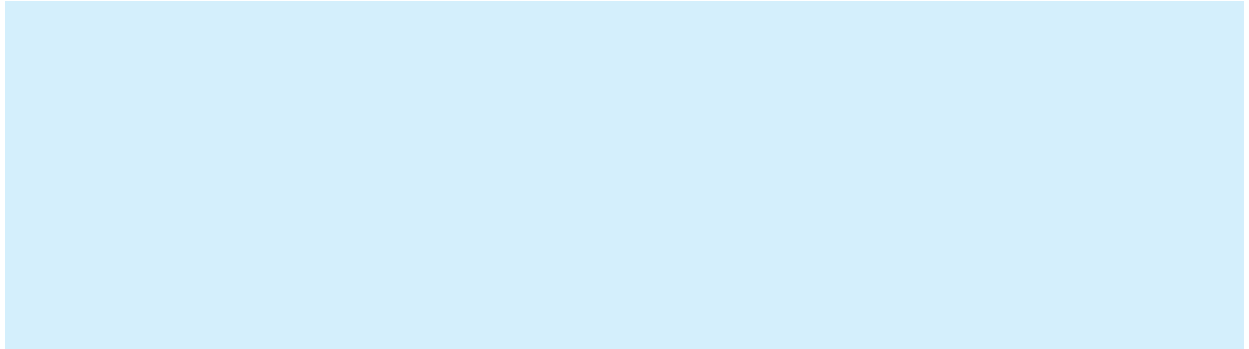

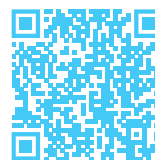

5 Now form larger groups. Plan a trip for the guest students from the partner class. Pay attention to the following aspects:

- Think about what the guests from India or Germany might be interested in.
- Plan your environmentally friendly round trip to the selected destinations.
- Think about how you travel: by train, by bike? You can just be creative and there are no limits to your ideas! All sustainable means of transport are allowed.
- Develop ideas as to which accommodations are suitable for an environmentally friendly trip and to what extent you can take local conditions into account.
- Also pay attention to other factors that are important in regards to the environment.
- Make sure that your travel concept is detailed, feasible and cost-saving.
