

## **B2 – Description of Course Content**

### **Common European Framework of Reference: B2**

- Can understand the main contents of complex texts on concrete and abstract topics; also understands specialized discussions in their own primary area of specialization.
- Can communicate so spontaneously and fluently that a normal conversation with native speakers is easily possible without a great deal of effort on either side.
- Can express themselves on a wide range of topics in a clear and detailed manner, explain their position on a current issue and indicate the benefits and drawbacks of various options.

#### **B2.1**

- Talk about material and emotional values and possessions
- Write a summary on personal relationships
- Understand information on personal wellbeing, sleep and work environment
- Present political opinions on inclusion, consumerism and petitions

#### **B2.2**

- Understand information about the housing market, applications, responsibilities of tenants and landlord, and travel accommodation
- Write a formal complaint and express personal opinion on housing topics
- Discuss media usage, chatbots, artificial intelligence, video and board games
- Present scientific topics, write a comment on mobility and transportation

#### **B2.3**

- Discuss the meaning of beauty and appearance in media and work settings
- Describe work conditions, participate in workplace coaching and write a formal message
- Give career and networking related tips and discuss gender equality at work
- Understand artist talks and present a piece of art or a project
- Talk about art and UNESCO world heritage sites

#### **B2.4**

- Express sensations and emotions
- Connect movement and emotion and talk about personal experiences
- Understand storytelling in marketing and analyse advertisements
- Write travel reports and understand travel podcasts
- Express personal views on how digitalisation has changed ways of travel
- Talk about the past and the future in regards to architecture and literature
