FAQs:
ORGANISER: The Goethe-Institut is Germany's official cultural institute encouraging international cultural exchange and promoting the study of German. We are a not-for-profit organisation; German Cultural Day is a free-entry, non-commercial event.
SITE: In-and-around the Goethe-Institut in Woollahra, including the <i>Euroka Reserve</i> park directly in front of the building and adjacent Jersey Road.
VENDORS: Food, drinks, small products, entertainment, information, community. Preference to vendors who have some relation to Germany, but others are by no means excluded. Every offer will be considered unless it is offensive or illegal.
INSURANCE: Stallholders must have and present their own public liability insurance with a minimum \$10 million cover in the stallholder's name. Those who sell food, drinks, oils, potions, medicines, cosmetics products, or massage services must also have their own product liability insurance with the same minimum cover.
WEATHER: The festival will go ahead in varying weather conditions, no refunds will be issued in case of bad weather. It is the responsibility of the stallholder to bring own rain covers and weights to hold down equipment in case of strong winds.
WASTE: Rubbish, waste and packaging must be taken away by the stallholder. The stall site must be left in the condition it was found.
ELECTRICITY: If you need electricity for your stall, this can be arranged. Please notify us at least 4 weeks in advance, so we can place you near a power point.
