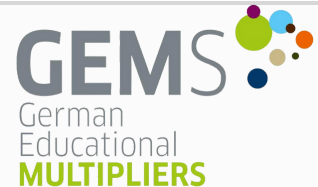
A global network of more than 2000 schools in 120 countries that maintains a close relationship to Germany and the German language.

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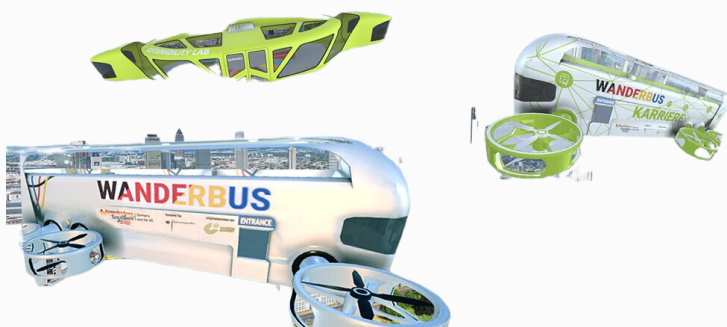
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PROJECTS FOR ALL AGES
