The Wednesday Movie Nights are a permanent feature of the program work of the Goethe-Institut Philippinen. The German society lives off immigration. Germany has been considered an immigration country since the late 1950s. The culture shock and the different lifestyle pose a great challenge for almost every immigrant coming to Germany.
