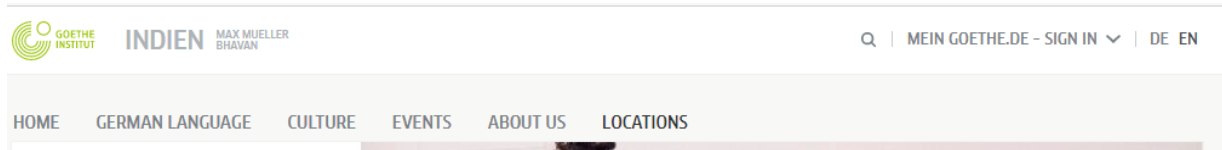


Registering and Logging In on Mein Goethe.de

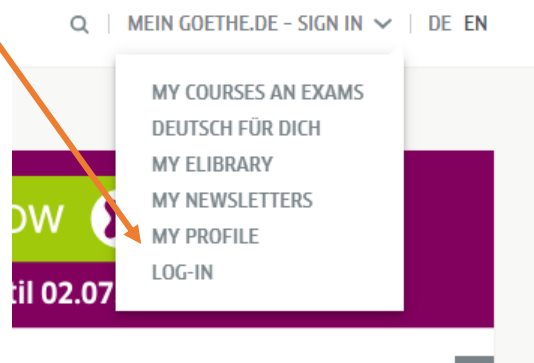
For candidates registered through language office or guardians

1. In case you have been registered by the language office or your guardian for the examination/course you will need to sign up to the learning platform.

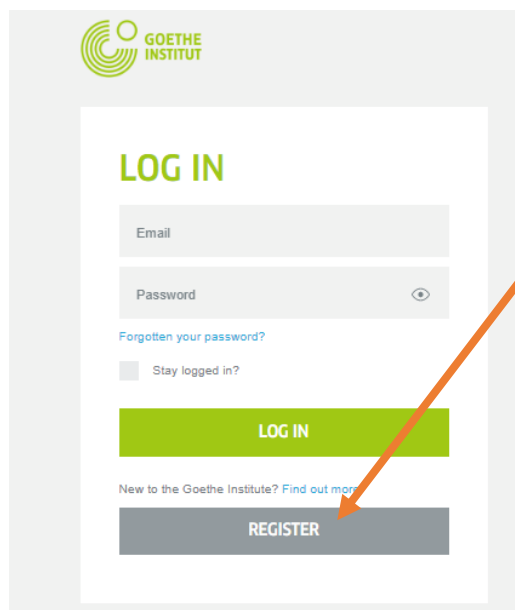
The entrance to the virtual world of the Goethe Institute is the **SIGN IN** button at www.goethe.de




2. Click on LOG-IN



3. This button will take you to the screen for registering and logging in. Click on Register




4. Use the e-mail id used by guardian or the one provided to the language office at the time of registration. Set a password and choose the country here. Click on Register.



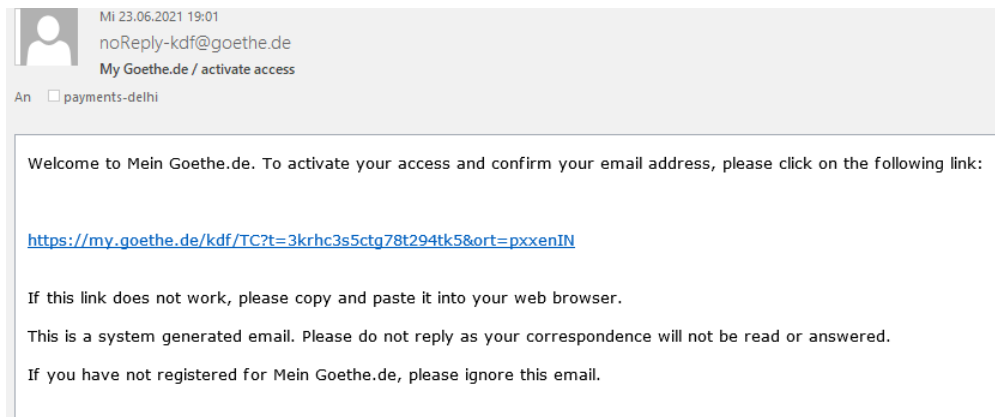

5. You will now see confirmation that you have registered successfully. Click on Close.

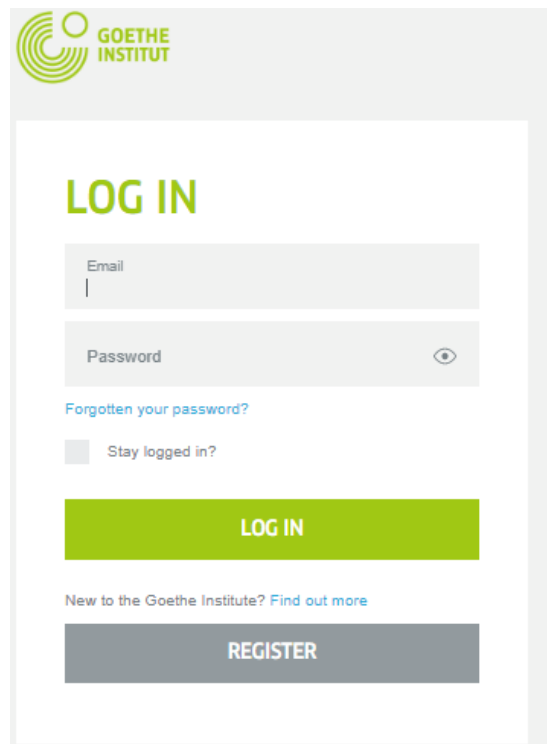

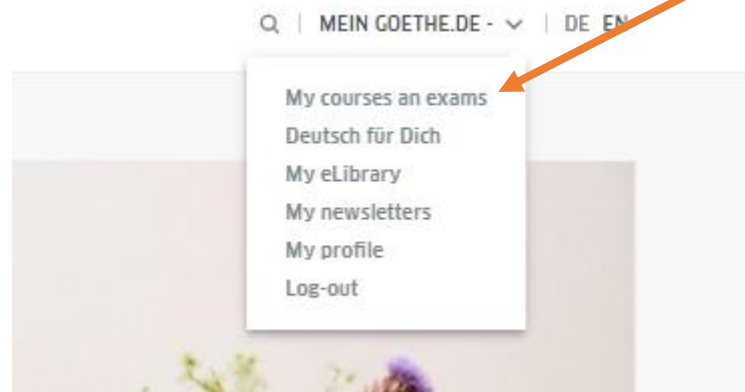
6. Check your inbox for an email with the sender noReply-kdf@goethe.de. Click on the link in the email to complete the verification process.

9. On the next screen you need to pair your e-mail account created on Mein Goethe.de using your **student number/customer number/ registration number starting with 006.....**

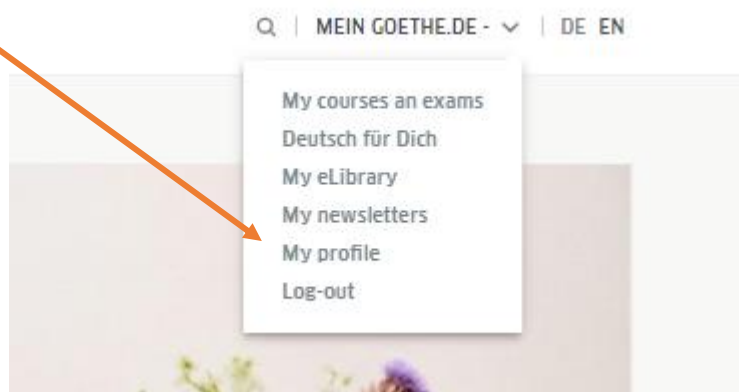
ADD A COURSE OR EXAM

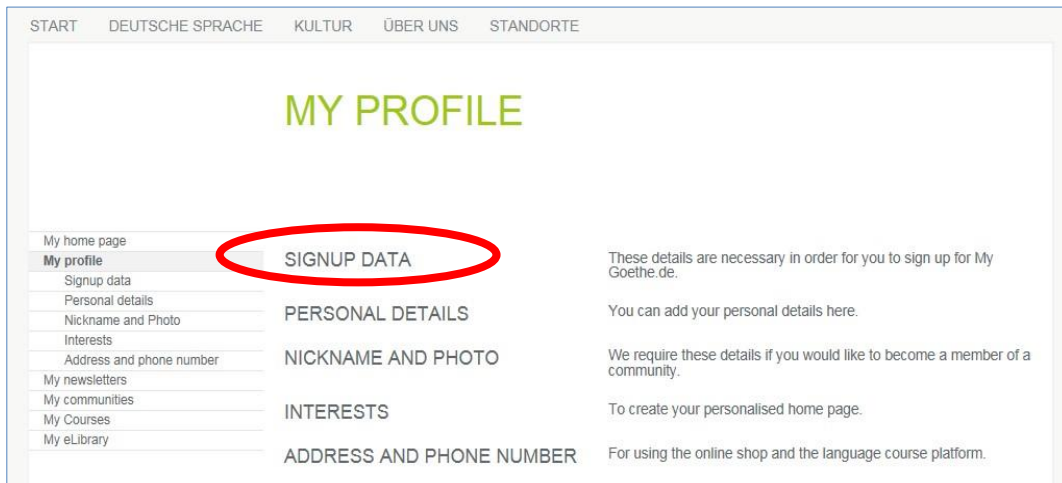
To gain access to your language course or exam for the first time you need to fill in your customer number or registration code. Your customer number can be found on letters or invoices from the Goethe-Institut.

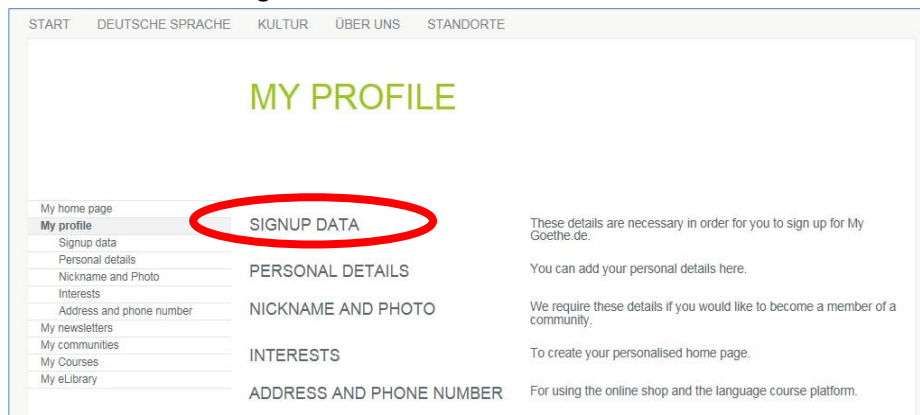

10. For successful pairing and access to your course/exam results, you must enter the same date of birth provided to the language office at the time of registration. The same can be access under My profile

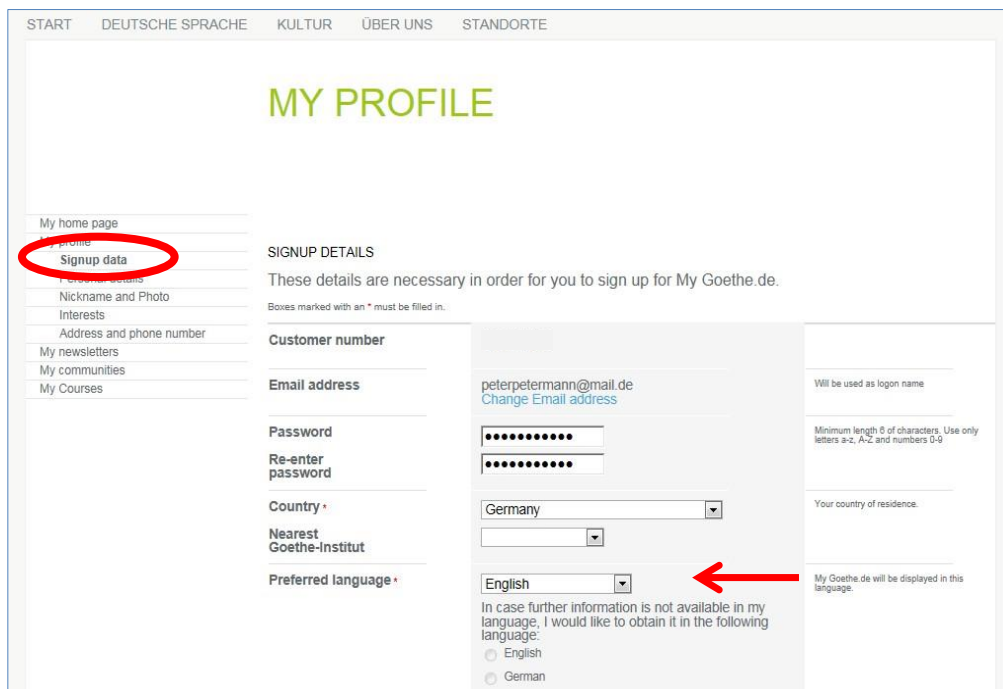
